**M25 MOTORWAY AND A40 TRUNK ROAD TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS**

Notice is hereby given that Highways England Company Limited has made an Order on the M25 Motorway and A40 Trunk Road in the Unitary Authority of Buckinghamshire Council and the London Borough of Hillingdon, under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because works are proposed to be executed on the road.

The effect of the Order is to authorise the phased overnight and weekend closure (details below) of:-

- a) both carriageways of the A40 between Denham Roundabout (A40/A412/A4020) and Swakeleys Roundabout (B467);
- b) all of the slip roads leading to and from the carriageways described in a) above;
- c) the roads connecting from both carriageways of the M25 to the London-bound carriageway of the M40 at Junction 16 (M40 Junction 1A);
- d) all of the side roads at junction with the carriageways described in a) above; and
- e) all of the lay-bys adjacent to the carriageways described in a) above.

These measures are in the interests of road safety while contractors undertake bridge joint replacement and all associated works.

It is expected that the work will last for approximately 8 weeks starting on or after Monday 5th October 2020. The majority of the work will be performed by overnight closures which will take place between the following hours (maximum periods) -

Monday - Thursday	22:00 - 05:30
Friday	23:00 - 06:00
Saturday	22:00 - 08:00
Sunday	22:30 - 05:30

There will be two weekend closures between 23:00 hours Friday 09 October and 16 October and 10:00 hours Sunday 11 October and 18 October respectively. Details of the closure will be found on Highways England website.

The Order will come into force on 3 October 2020 and have a maximum duration of eighteen months, ceasing when the works are complete.

Traffic affected by the closures in a) above will be diverted using the A4020, B483, and B467 in both directions. Traffic affected by the closures in c) above will be diverted westbound on the M40 to Junction 2 (A355) and return. Access in to or from the Swaminarayan Temple will be maintained under works control.

The temporary closures and diversion routes will be clearly indicated by traffic signs when they are in operation during the works period.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 PUBLIC INQUIRY TO BE HELD AS A VIRTUAL EVENT Opening on 8 October 2020 at 10:00**REASON FOR INQUIRY**

Appeal by A40 Data Centre B.V. relating to the application to Old Oak and Park Royal Development Corporation (OPDC) for demolition of the existing building and redevelopment to provide a ground plus ten storey building and two levels of basement to provide flexible industrial uses (Use Class B2/B8) over ground and first floor, offices (Use Class B1a) at second floor and hotel (Use Class C1) uses on floors three to ten, and associated car parking, servicing and all necessary enabling works at 628 Western Avenue, Park Royal, London. An Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State will hold an Inquiry opening on the date shown above to decide the appeal. - NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Westminster City Council on 21st September 2020 made the above Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- The general effect of the Orders will be to:
 - prohibit goods vehicles, the maximum gross weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes, from entering Homer Street, except for access and the purposes of deliveries and maintenance of services;
 - relocate the pay-by-phone parking bay on the south-west side of Homer Street, opposite Nos. 1 to 10 Cranfield Court, north-westward by 8.5 metres; and
 - introduce double yellow line "at any time" waiting and loading restrictions on the south-west side of Homer Street, extending from its junction with Crawford Street to opposite Nos. 1 to 10 Cranfield Court.
