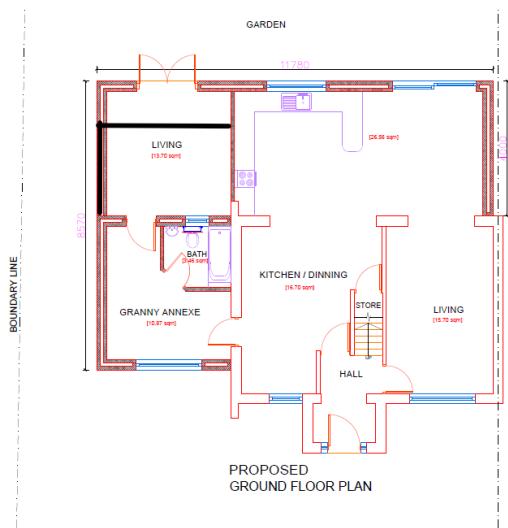
Jawad,

Thank you for your plans.

Having checked the planning history I don't believe we have refused a proposal similar to that tabled.i.e. with a single storey rear element behind the proposed two-storey side extension. I also note that the single storey rear element has been increased in depth to 4m and that 48 has a an existing single storey rear extension.

I must apologise as I didn't realise I had attached the wrong file to the email. I've attached the correct file to this email.

I don't intend to increase the depth of the single storey rear element from what has already been approved. It is just increasing the width of this extension (please see the correct drawings).
