The information provided below summarises a response to those queries posed on the
planning application form, however the Demolition Method Statement should be referred to for
a comprehensive understanding of the demolition and site restoration.

Description of the buildings to be demolished

The buildings and structures proposed for demolition are situated across at 371a Harlington
High Street as shown on the submitted Demolition Site Plan, shaded in red. The site is known
as The Elms which contains a number of industrial, storage and retail units of various types and
sizes. The Elms is accessed via Harlington High Street which borders the site to the west,
backing on to a number of residential gardens. The site is bound to the north, south and east
by vegetation and predominantly agricultural uses.

Proposed method of demolition

Please refer to the comprehensive Demolition Management Plan submitted with this application
for full details of the proposed method and management of the demolition of buildings,
structures and hardstanding, which will be undertaken by specialist contractors.

The management statement includes for service disconnections, asbestos removal, erection of temporary works as necessary, soft strip, scaffold erection, demolition, 100mm yard scrape as well as the method of clearance and transportation of debris arising to licensed disposal/recycling sites.

Proposed Restoration

Upon completion of the works, the site will be left in a level and tidy condition. The site will then be secured via existing methods.

As per the documents provided as part of this application, we confirm that a site notice has been displayed in a visible location at the entrance to the site.
