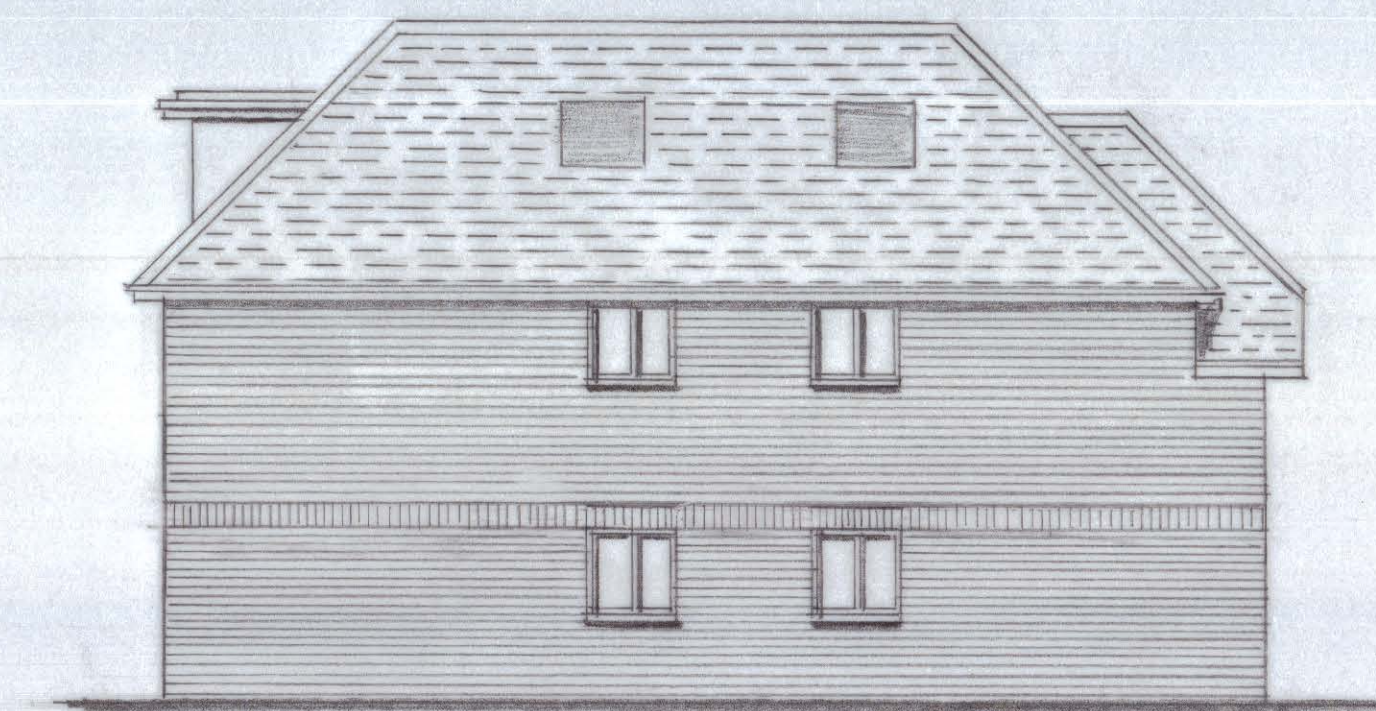




SIDE ELEVATION (towards 95)
