Internally within kitchen, recent modern plasterboard to be replaced with identical modern plasterboard ceiling (last approved/ upgraded c1995).

Internally, modern conservatory floor raised to agree with the existing kitchen floor construction.

Externally, the porous corrugated cement kitchen roof lean-to is proposed to be removed and replaced with a warm roof thermally insulated SIPS panel, with grey lead appearance replacement roof detail here, with associated new roof glazing (last approved/ upgraded c1995).

Existing c1990s flashings retained.

Externally, reposition/ replace 1st floor rear modern large landing window with smaller timber casement window salvaged from the kitchen, to match.

Externally, existing (modern) conservatory doors replaced with timber framed conservation-grade double glazed replacements.
