Condition 10 – Privacy Screens

I have attached revised drawings for the Privacy Screens which removes the 45 degree bars in favour of a simple powder coated aluminium screen which should address any concerns about over-looking between properties.

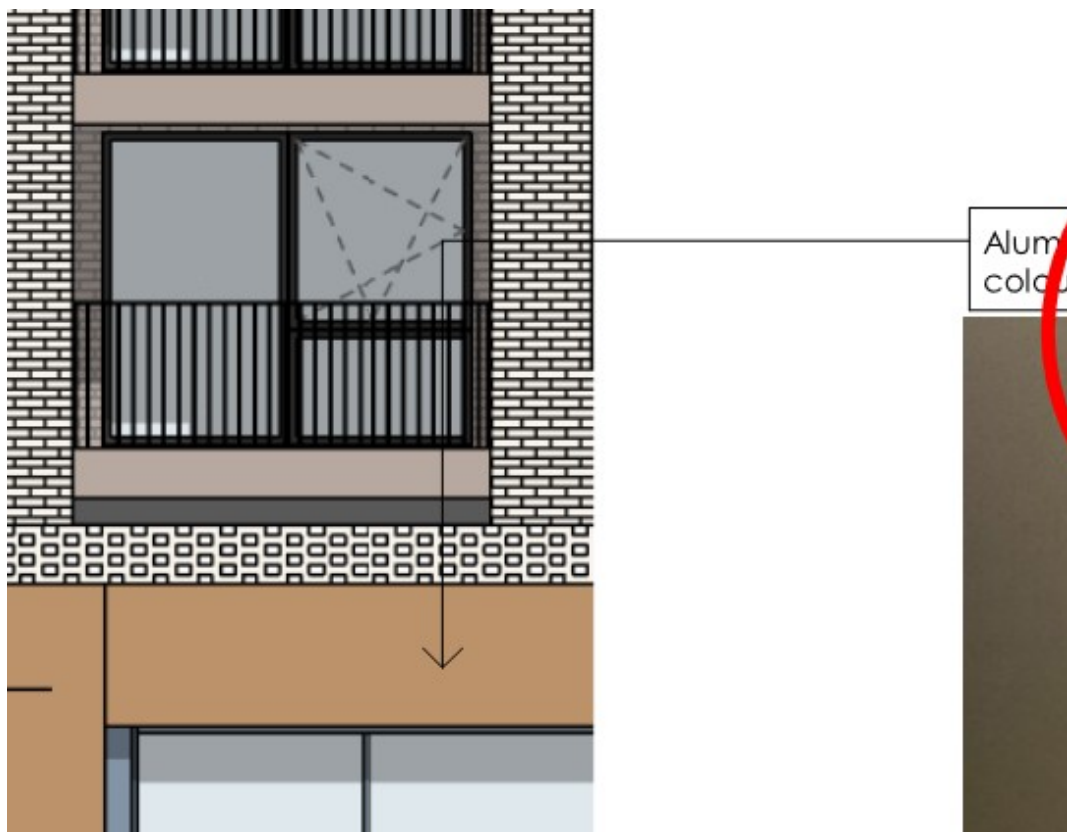

Hi Richard

I have just responded via the CRS, as follows:

CONDITION 5: Materials and external surfaces (ref. 2019/2880)

Hester drawing 2-910 Rev A provides a plan with colour-coded hard surfacing. The last item on the schedule is J (Deck paving) - no deck paving is indicated on plan.

The plan is supported by a written schedule of materials and suppliers.

Details of balcony railings have been submitted.

RECOMMENDATION

Clarification is required regarding the whereabouts of the deck paving on site? No information available regarding the external walls / boundary treatments.

CONDITION 7: Landscape scheme (ref. 2018/2793)

No soft landscape details have been submitted. The drawing submitted under ref. 2370/APP/2018/2793 was a masterplan showing an indicative layout only.

RECOMMENDATION

Full landscape details (by a landscape consultant), with detailed plans, schedules, specification of work and a management / maintenance plan are required.
