**PUBLIC NOTICE by Westminster City Council**  
Notice is hereby given that Westminster City Council proposes to make an order under subsections 247 (2A), (2B) and (3) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 ("the 1990 Act"), the general effect of which will be to authorise the stopping up of a total of 75.37 square metre area of the highways Berkeley Square and Berkeley Street to enable the development to be carried out at the premises Lansdowne House, Berkeley Square, London W1 6ER ("the Building"), comprising the alteration of the alignment of the ground floor external wall of that building. The parts of the highway that the order is to authorise to be stopped up about the present ground floor external wall of the Building and extend as follows:

(a) The parts of the highway Berkeley Square situated between the distances (in metres) from the highway Fitzmaurice Place, as listed in column 1 of the table below, that extend for the corresponding distance in column 2 of the table below, as follows:

- (i) Column 1: Distances in metres from the corner of Berkeley Square and Fitzmaurice Place,
- (ii) Column 2: Distances in metres that are perpendicular to a straight line in Berkeley Square that extends between that highway's corners with Fitzmaurice Place and Berkeley Street

(ii) eight semi-circles projecting into Berkeley Square from the above parts of the highway Berkeley Square the radius of each being 0.65 metres, the centre of each of four of the semi-circles being situated 6.15; 12.15, 18.15; 24.15 metres from Berkeley Street respectively and four of the semi-circles being situated 6.15; 12.15, 18.15; 24.15 metres from Fitzmaurice Place, respectively.

(b) The parts of the highway Berkeley Street comprising

- (iii) three semi-circular areas of the highway Berkeley Street of which each extends by a maximum distance of 0.45 metres, in a direction that is perpendicular to the middle line of that highway, and situated between the distances 6 and 7.2 metres, 10.0 and 11.2 metres and between 14.05 and 15.1 metres from the highway Lansdowne Row, and
- (iv) and one semi-circular area that extends by a maximum distance of 0.15 metres, in a direction that is perpendicular to the middle line of that highway between 18.15 and 19.05 metres from Lansdowne Row

Pursuant to sub-section 247 (2B) of the 1990 Act, it is proposed that the order will also provide for improvements to the highways Berkeley Street and Lansdowne Row, as follows:

(a) the widening of the length of the highway Berkeley Street by a segment of a semi-circular area that extends by a distance of 5.8 metres from Lansdowne Row, along the longest length of the segment, in a direction that is parallel to the middle line of Berkeley Street and by a maximum distance of 1.75 metres in a direction that is perpendicular to that middle line and

(b) the widening of the complete 71.6 metres length of the highway Lansdowne Row by a uniform distance of 0.8 metres in a direction that is perpendicular to the middle line of that highway.

Pursuant to sub-section 247 (3) of the 1990 Act those highway improvements are to be maintained at the public expense by the body that is the highway authority for Lansdowne Row and Berkeley Street (for the purposes of the Highways Act 1980).
