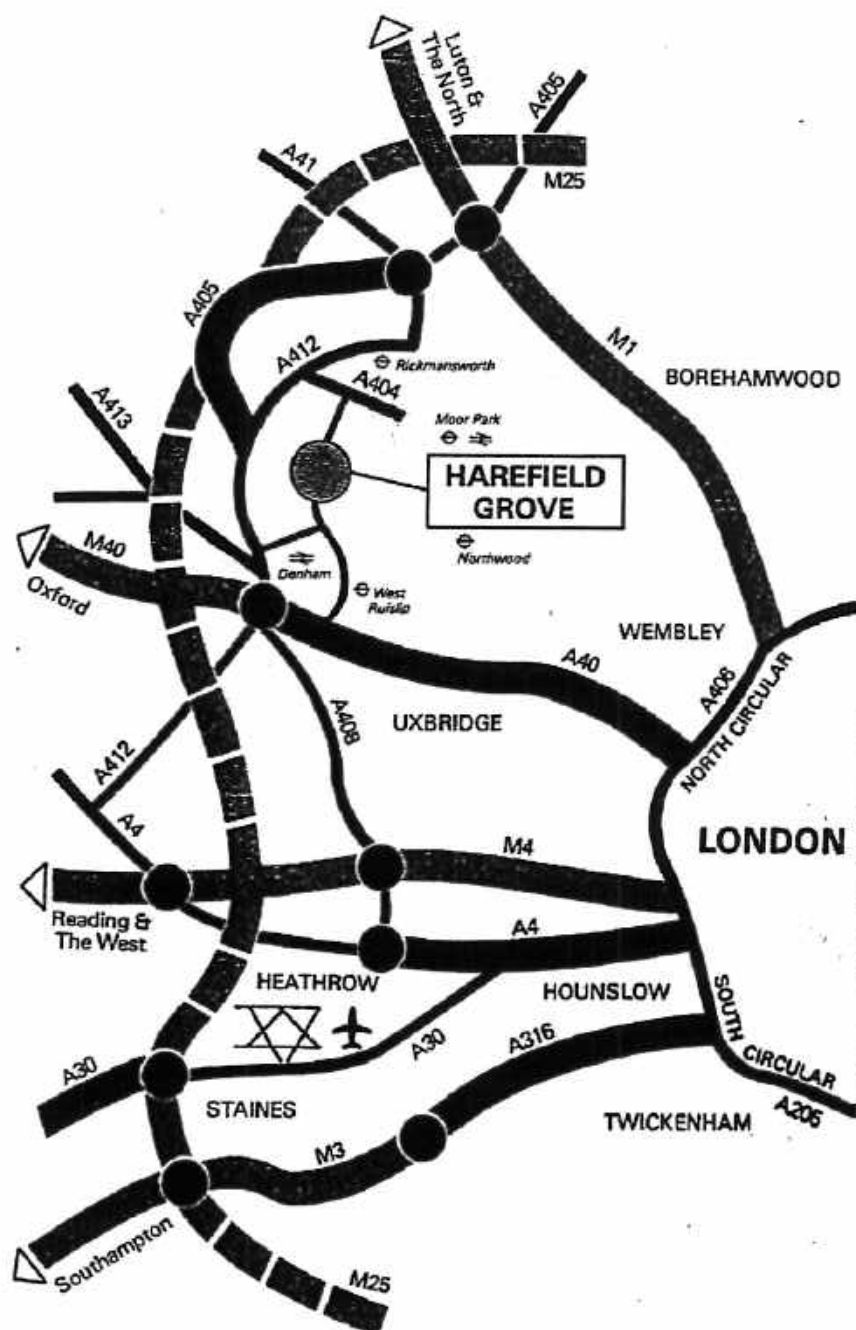

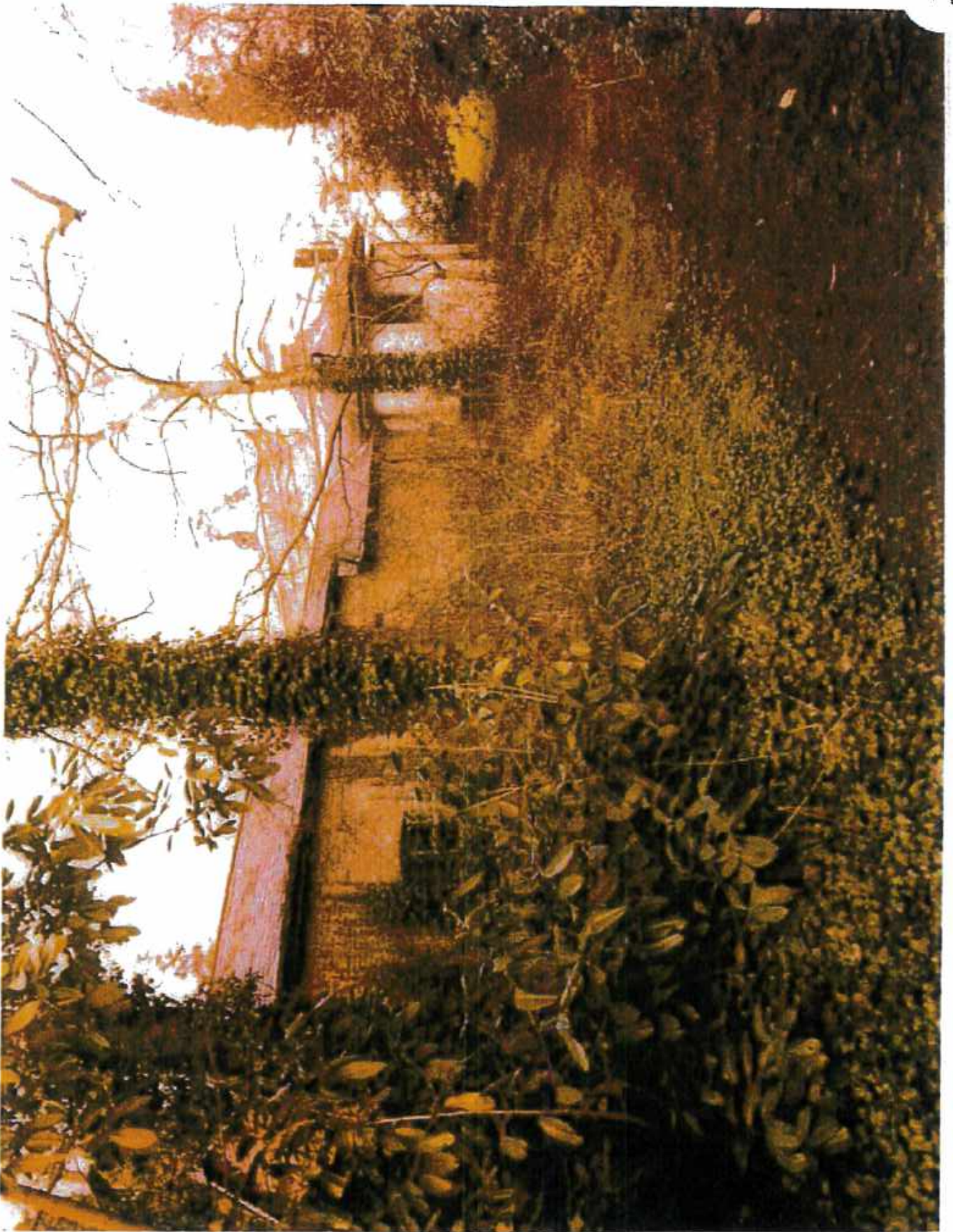


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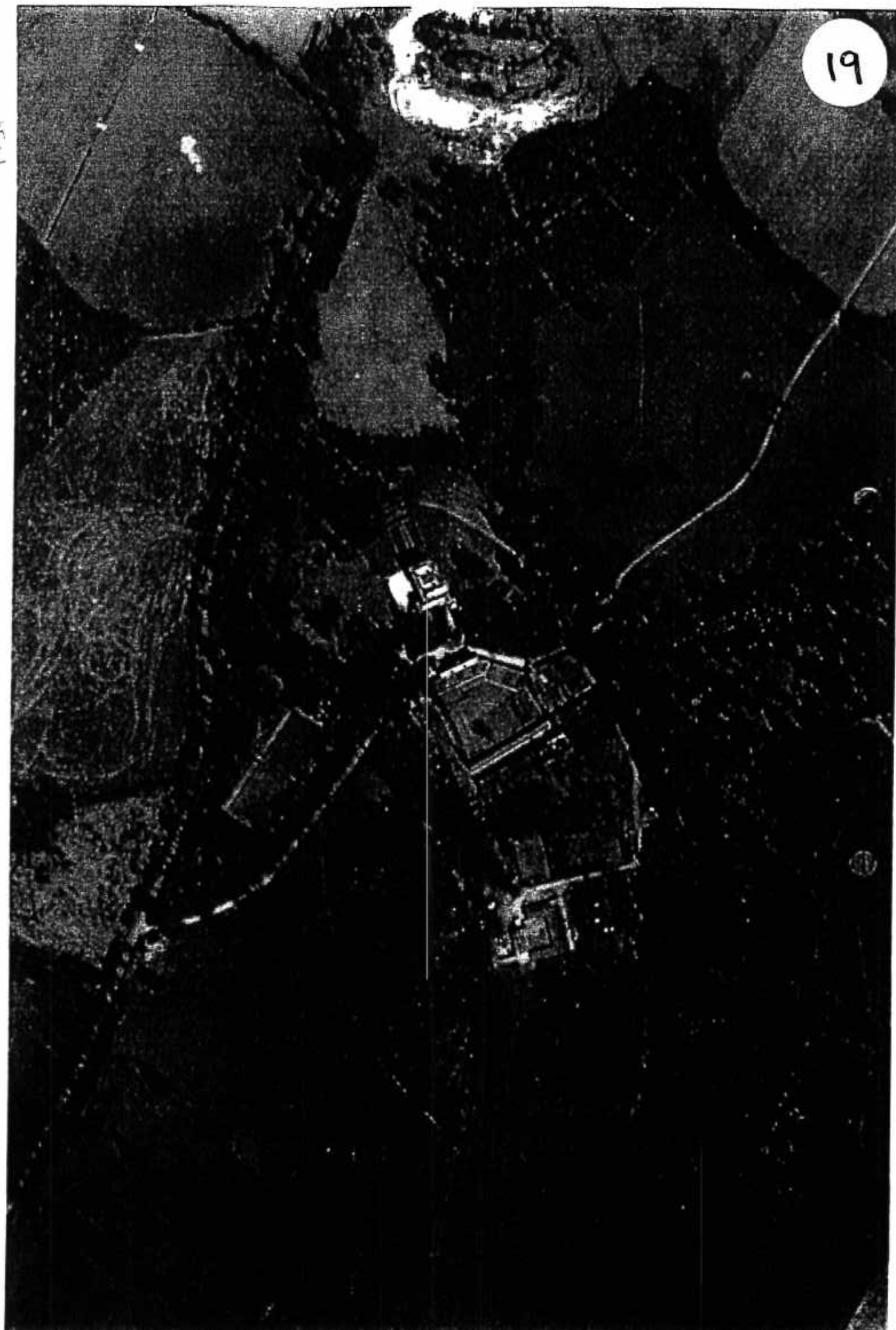


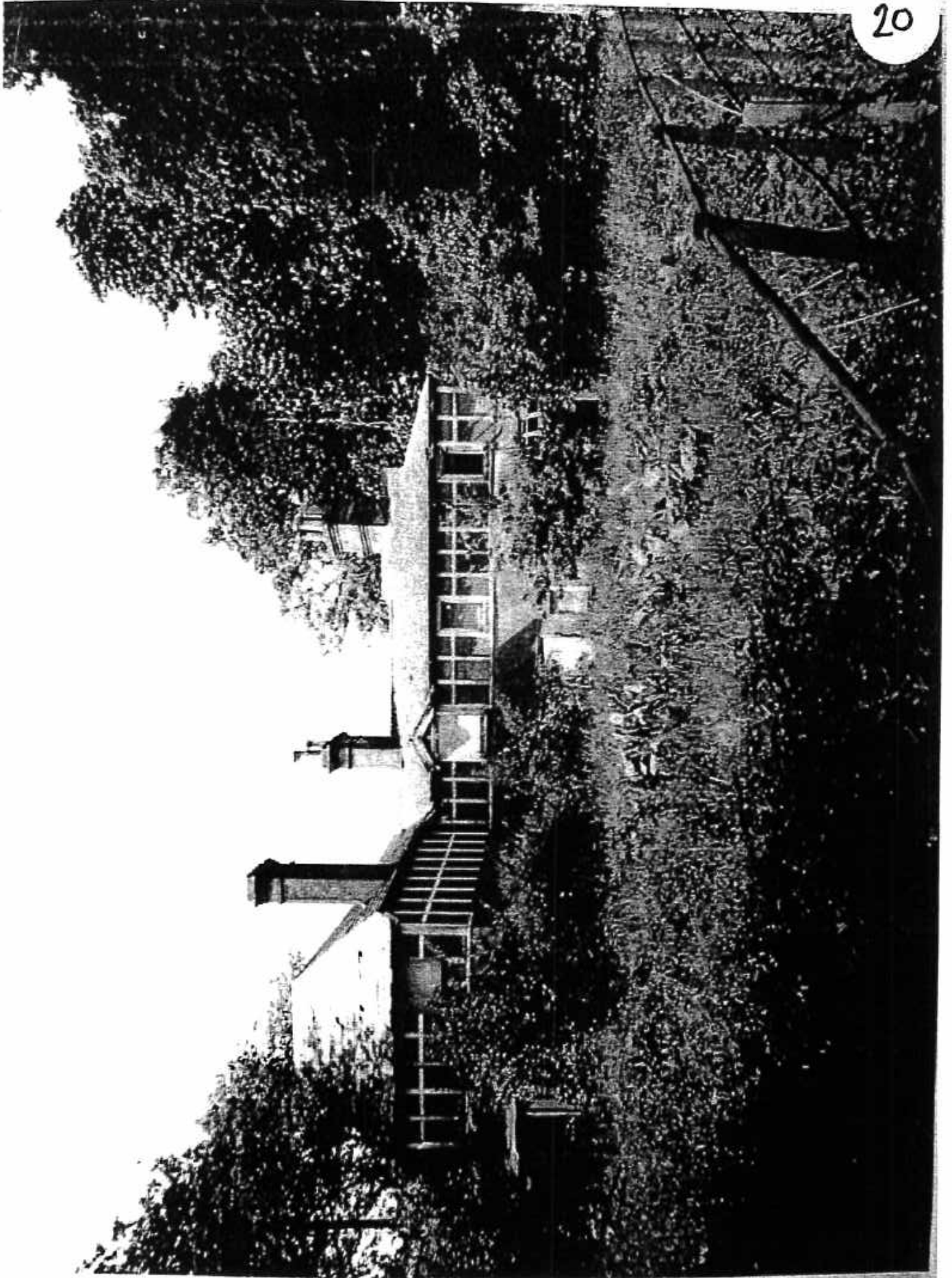




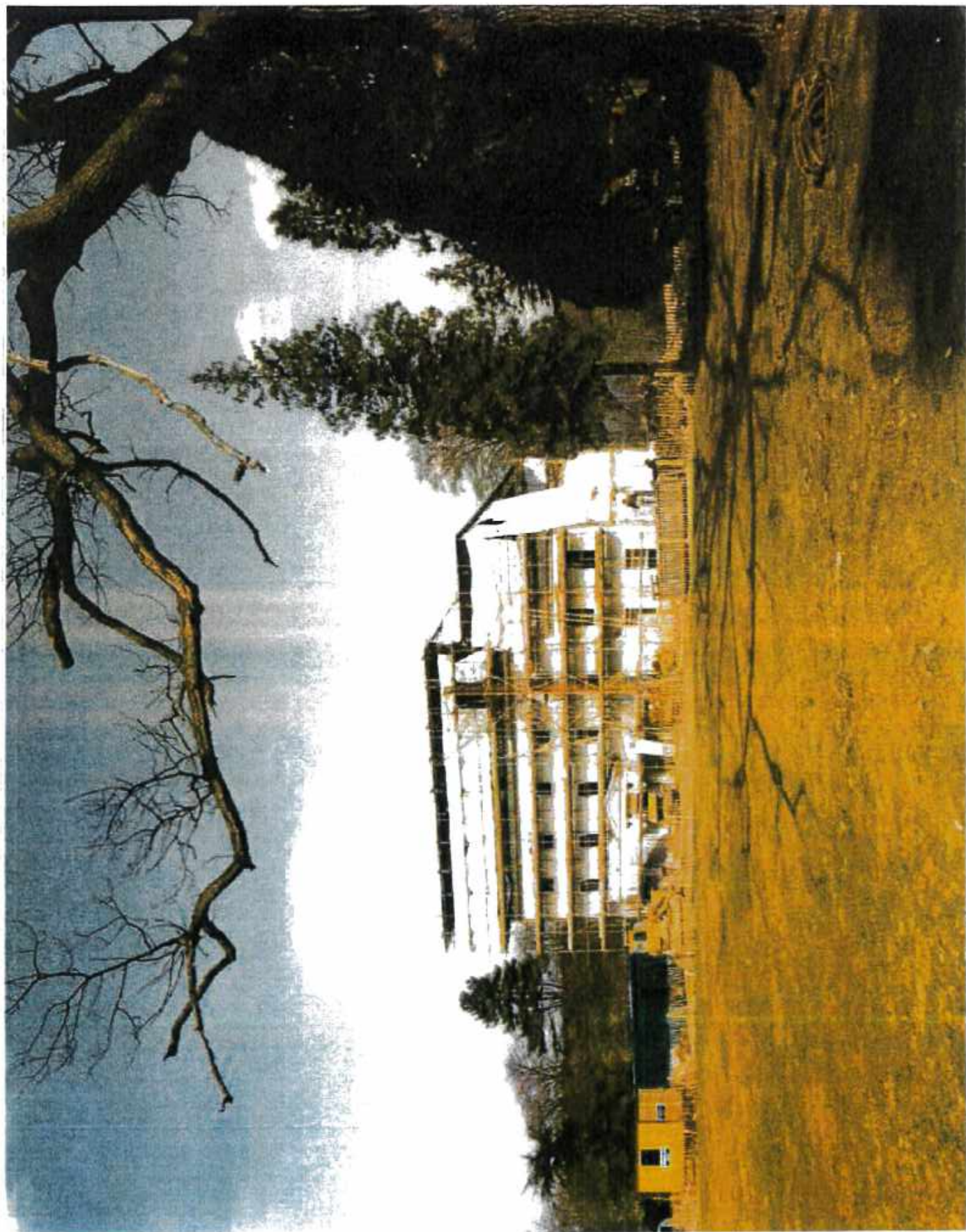


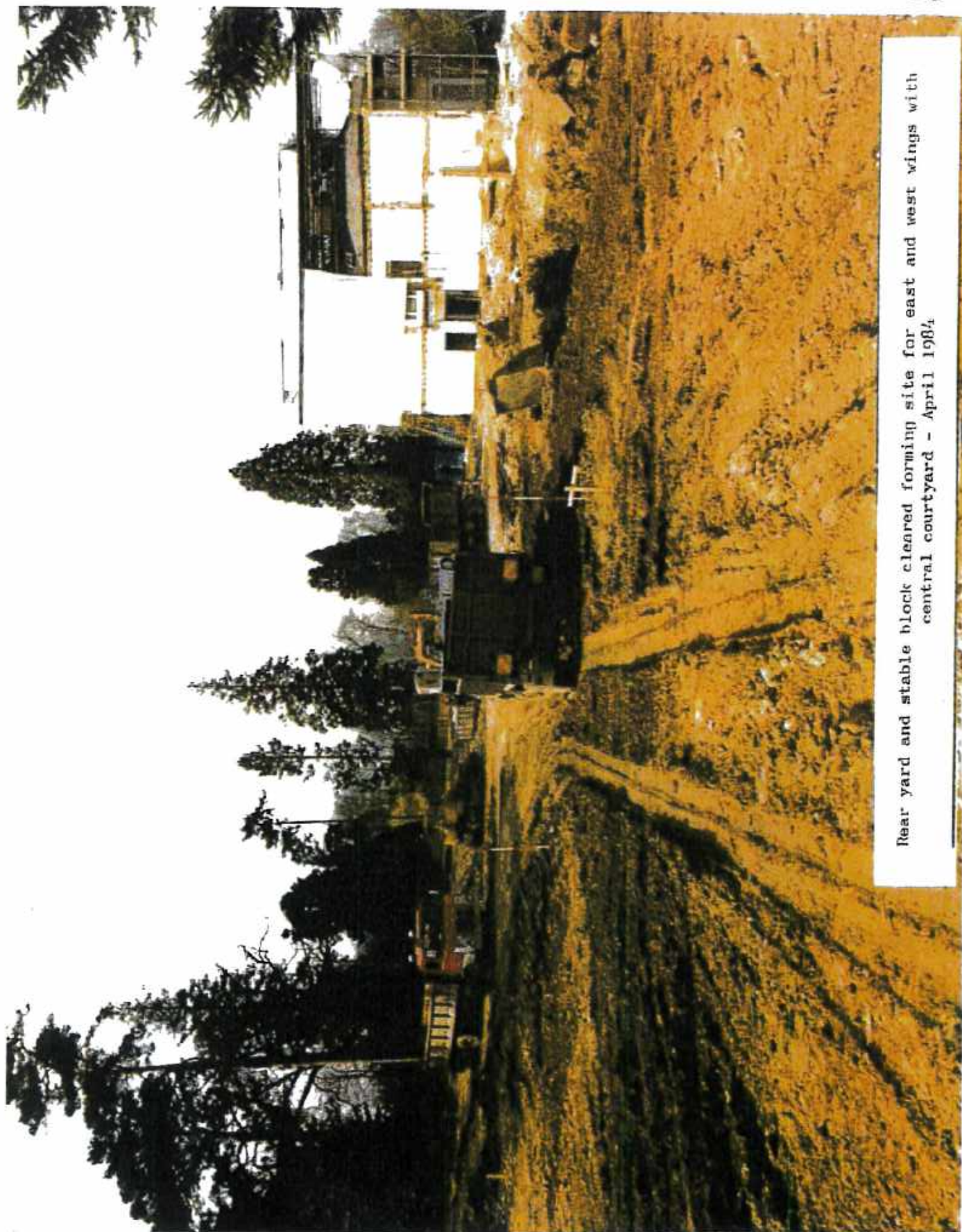












Rear yard and stable block cleared forming site for east and west wings with
central courtyard - April 1984



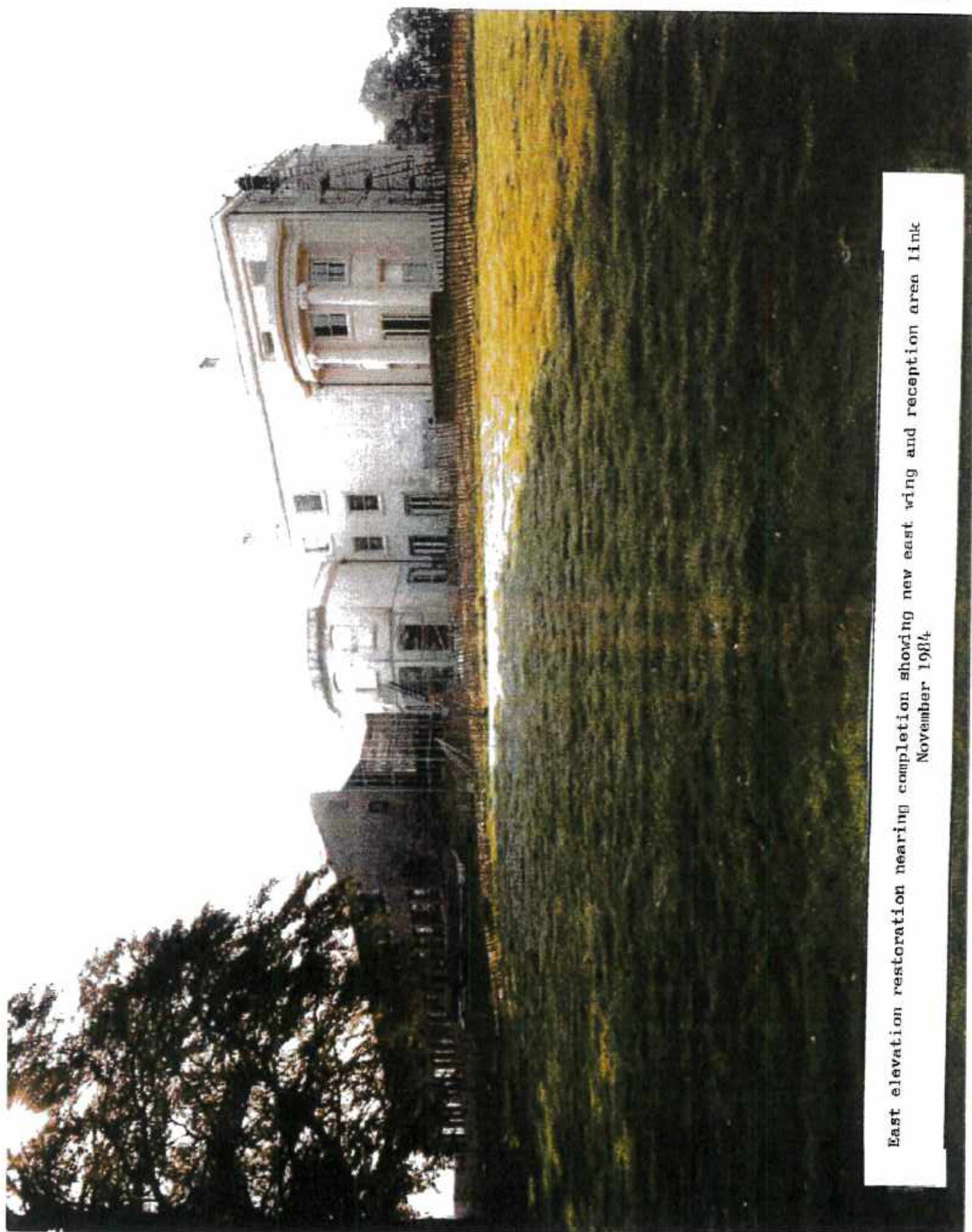
Old staff quarters demolished, underpinning and excavation for east wing in progress
