



PLANTERS (car park side)



Clematis 'The President'
Hardy Garden Climber Plant.

The area immediately in front of the noise reduction fence will be populated with Clematis 'The President' Hardy Garden Climber Plant.

Plant Height will be supported to climb the height of the fence as indicated on the drawings

Characteristics: Hardy deciduous climber with mid-green foliage and large violet single flowers.

Growth & Spread: ultimate height of 1 - 2m and spread of 0.5 - 1m.

Flourishing Season: Flowers bloom from late Spring into Summer and again late Summer into Autumn.

To be planted half a metre apart and maintained to support early growth. Water frequently while the plant is getting established.

Maintain moist and well-drained soil as this plant prefers partial sun as full sun may cause bleaching or fading of colour from the flower petals. Regular watering through dry period required.

Produce flowers on the previous year's growth. Remove weak or damaged stems to allow for fresh growth and trim the rest of the stems back to just above the highest pair of buds. Use restraint, or it won't flower that year. Prune lightly for repeat flowering.

PLANTERS (Playground side)

To be used for children's learning / play planting and growing. Therefore various plants as required by nursery to be used
