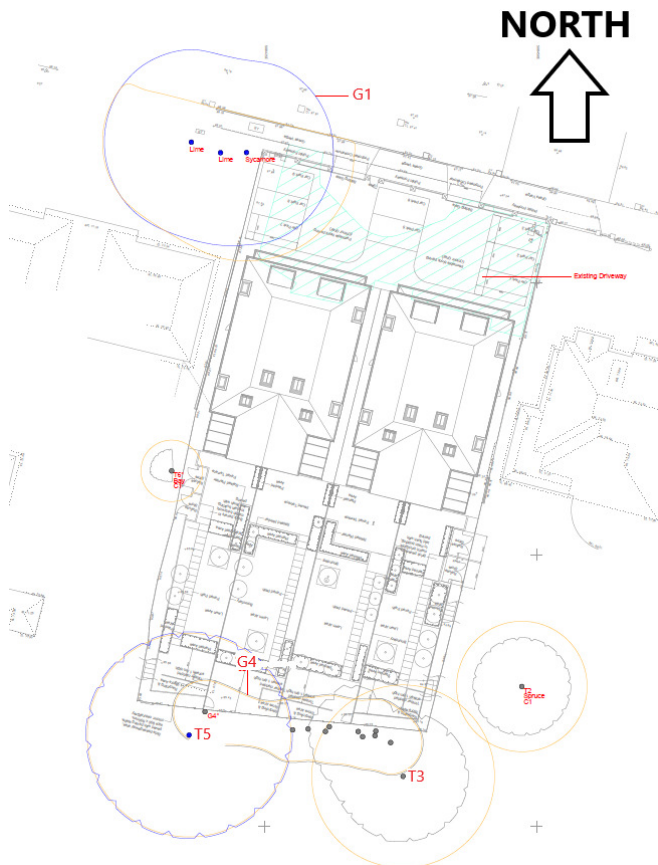
Dear Mr Prichard,

**RE: Trees at 25 The Avenue, Northwood, HA6 2NJ**

Thank you for your instruction to undertake an assessment of the trees at the above site. You asked me to undertake a visual assessment of some of the trees make recommendations for their future management. I duly visited the site on the 19<sup>th</sup> October 2023 and can now advise as follows.

**Site plan:**

The trees I surveyed are shown on the plan below; only G1, T3, G4 and T5 are relevant to this survey.

**Tree details (current dimensions):**G1 – sycamore

Height = 24m. Stem diameter = 700mm (measured at 1.5m in height).  
Crown radius = 8.5m in all directions.

T3 - ash

Height 18m. Stem diameter 700mm (measured at 1.5m in height).  
Crown radius = north: 10m, east: 6m, south: 6m, west: 10m.

G4 – sycamore and holly

Height 12m. Stem diameter 240mm (measured at 1.5m in height).  
Crown radius = 3m in all directions.

T5 – sycamore

Height 24m. Stem diameter 780mm (measured at 1.5m in height).  
Crown radius = 9.5m in all directions.

**Proposed works / recommendations:**G1 – sycamore

- Reduce crown laterally by 3.5m to east and south.

Reason for works

- To manage crown as canopy almost in contact with nearby buildings (see current crown on plan above)

T3 - ash

- Reduce crown laterally to boundary line.

Reason for works:

- Manage overlong lateral limbs at risk of failure.

G4 – sycamore and holly

- Reduce crown laterally to boundary line.

Reason for works:

- Manage scrub growth over rear gardens.

T5 – sycamore

- Reduce crown laterally on north side by 4m.

Reason for works:

- Manage crown over rear garden.

All of the above tree works will be required to be in accord with British Standard 3998 – 2010 (Tree Work - Recommendations).
