Wenzel's the Bakers were established in 1975 and have grown from a small Bakery behind their shop in Pinner, to presently c.100 shops and being requested by customers to open in new towns/locations.

Whilst the daily fresh quality of the product and service of the staff is key, alongside this is the important ingredient of a shop that invites customers to enjoy the ambience of the Wenzel's brand.

All new shops are therefore fully refitted including a new shopfront. This even includes when they have taken over shops fully fitted and previously trading as Bakers, who have gone out of business.

By continuously investing and updating they now offer a modern format of a high street bakers shop. Their shopfront presentation has also endeavoured to keep up with the times, and particularly in this respect since 2010 they have introduced automatic doors in the centre of the shopfront.

This has made access and of course leaving so much easier for all customers. No longer are kids stranded on the wrong side of the door, while their Mum tries to navigate a buggy; and of course this also provides a welcoming experience for those in wheelchairs.
