## Title of order

This order can be referred to as: **Temporary traffic order for planned works - TT 3218 Broadway, West Ealing - 2021.**

## Reason for order

This order is needed to allow for works taking place on or near the road. These works involve Thames Water making a new water connection to number 55 Broadway, West Ealing.

## Effect of order

- Eastbound bus lane between properties 70 to 96 will be suspended - open to all traffic from 6<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> July 2021.
- The following temporary restrictions on vehicle movements will take effect from 6<sup>th</sup> July:
  - No entry into the fully closed section of Broadway;
  - No waiting, loading or unloading on either side of the carriageway within the fully closed section.
- The above temporary restrictions and prohibitions will only apply at specified locations where appropriate traffic signs are provided and displayed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the Traffic Signs Manual.
- While the temporary restrictions are in place, displaced vehicles should follow the diversions displayed in place to reach their destinations and comply with any traffic management measures.

## M25 &amp; M40 MOTORWAYS AND A40 TRUNK ROAD (DENHAM VIADUCT)

## TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS

Notice is hereby given that Highways England Company Limited intends to make an Order on the M25 and M40 Motorways and the A40 Trunk Road in the London Borough of Hillingdon and the Unitary Authority of Buckinghamshire Council, under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because works are proposed to be executed on the road.

The effect of the Order would be to authorise the 24-hour closure of -

- both carriageways of the M40 and A40 between Junction 1 (A40/A412/A4020) and Swakeleys Roundabout (B467/B483), and all slip roads leading to and from this length;
- the roads connecting from both carriageways of the M25 to the London-bound carriageway of the M40 at Junction 16 (M40 Junction 1A); and
- the lay-by adjacent to the London-bound carriageway of the A40 between Junction 1 (A40/A412/A4020) and Swakeleys Roundabout (B467/B483).

These measures would be in the interests of road safety while contractors undertake bridge, geotechnical, carriageway, drainage, and electrical works, surveys, vegetation clearance, and all associated works.

It is expected that the work would last for approximately 8 weeks starting on or after Friday 16th July 2021. The weekend closures would take place between 22:00 hours on a Friday until 12:00 hours on a Sunday. Weekday closures would take place between 22:00 and 12:00 the following day.

The Order would come into force on 14th July 2021 and have a maximum duration of eighteen months, ceasing when the works are complete.

Traffic affected by the closures would be diverted using other junctions of the M25 and M40 or by using the A4020, B467 and the B483. Access to and from the Swaminarayan Temple would be maintained under escort.

The temporary closures and diversion routes would be clearly indicated by traffic signs when they are in operation during the works period.

VARIOUS ROADS -  
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS

- The Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea hereby give notice that to facilitate highway maintenance works they intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to impose temporary restrictions on vehicular traffic in the sections of the streets as listed in paragraph II below. In addition, the alternative routes are also shown. Directly affected residents will be notified in advance of the dates and anticipated duration of each closure. However, to allow for contingencies the order will remain in force for eighteen months.

- Bassett Road** - closure of a section of carriageway between St Marks Road and Ladbrooke Grove. Alternative route for vehicular traffic is via Oxford Gardens and Ladbrooke Grove.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984  
SECTION 14(1)

- Hillingdon Council gives notice that to enable carriageway improvement works to be carried out by O'Hara Bros and to prevent the likelihood of danger to the public it intends to make this Order, which will temporarily close:
  - Blyth Road, Hayes from outside the common boundary of 23 to the junction of Clarendon Road.
  - Clarendon Road, Hayes southbound traffic only
  - Clayton Road, Hayes, from the junction of Station Road
  - Division route will be in place via
    - Blyth Road - Access only
    - Clarendon Road - Southbound traffic only
    - Clayton Road - Clarendon Road, Blyth Road, Dawley Road, North Hyde Road, Station Road.
- Nothing in the Order shall apply to prevent vehicular access to premises on or adjacent to the prohibited length of road insofar as access is reasonably practicable without interference with the said works.

- The Order, which is proposed will come into operation on 7th July 2021, will continue in force for eighteen months or until work to which it relates is completed. However it is anticipated that the works will be completed within 61 Days.
