#### NOTICE OF INTENT TO CREATE A TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDER FOR PLANNED WORKS AFFECTING: BROADWAY, WEST EALING W13.

Ealing Council intends to make the following temporary traffic order under section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:

##### Title of order

This order can be referred to as: Temporary traffic order for planned works - TT 3218 Broadway, West Ealing - 2021.

##### Reason for order

This order is needed to allow for works taking place on or near the road. These works involve Thames Water making a new water connection to number 55 Broadway, West Ealing.

##### Effect of order

1. Eastbound bus lane between properties 70 to 96 will be suspended - open to all traffic from 6<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> July 2021.

2. The following temporary restrictions on vehicle movements will take effect from 6<sup>th</sup> July:

(a) No entry into the fully closed section of Broadway;

(b) No waiting, loading or unloading on either side of the carriageway within the fully closed section.

3. The above temporary restrictions and prohibitions will only apply at specified locations where appropriate traffic signs are provided and displayed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the Traffic Signs Manual.

4. While the temporary restrictions are in place, displaced vehicles should follow the diversions displayed in place to reach their destinations and comply with any traffic management measures.

5. This Order does not apply to:

(a) anything done at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a police community support officer (PCSO);

(b) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

##### Date order will come into force

##### Maximum duration of order

These works are expected to be completed by 10<sup>th</sup> July 2021.

### M25 & M40 MOTORWAYS AND A40 TRUNK ROAD (DENHAM VIADUCT) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS

Notice is hereby given that Highways England Company Limited intends to make an Order on the M25 and M40 Motorways and the A40 Trunk Road in the London Borough of Hillingdon and the Unitary Authority of Buckinghamshire Council, under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because works are proposed to be executed on the road.

The effect of the Order would be to authorise the 24-hour closure of –

1. both carriageways of the M40 and A40 between Junction 1 (A40/A412/A4020) and Swakeleys Roundabout (B467/B483), and all slip roads leading to and from this length;
2. the roads connecting from both carriageways of the M25 to the London-bound carriageway of the M40 at Junction 16 (M40 Junction 1A); and
3. the lay-by adjacent to the London-bound carriageway of the A40 between Junction 1 (A40/A412/A4020) and Swakeleys Roundabout (B467/B483).

These measures would be in the interests of road safety while contractors undertake bridge, geotechnical, carriageway, drainage, and electrical works, surveys, vegetation clearance, and all associated works.

It is expected that the work would last for approximately 8 weeks starting on or after Friday 16th July 2021. The weekend closures would take place between 22:00 hours on a Friday until 12:00 hours on a Sunday. Weekday closures would take place between 22:00 and 12:00 the following day. The Order would come into force on 14th July 2021 and have a maximum duration of eighteen months, ceasing when the works are complete.

Traffic affected by the closures would be diverted using other junctions of the M25 and M40 or by using the A4020, B467 and the B483. Access to and from the Swaminarayan Temple would be maintained under escort.

The temporary closures and diversion routes would be clearly indicated by traffic signs when they are in operation during the works period.

Ealing Council intends to make the following temporary traffic order under section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:

##### Title of order

This order can be referred to as: Temporary traffic order for planned works - TT 3235 Old Oak Common Lane, Acton W3 - 2021.

##### Reason for order

This order is needed to allow for works taking place on or near the road. These works involve Network Rail - Cadent Gas HS2 and Thames Water carrying out drainage works on the overhead rail bridge on Old Oak Common Lane.

##### Effect of order

1. Old Oak Common Lane will be closed between Wulfstan Street and Wells House Road

2. The following temporary restrictions on vehicle movements will take effect from 01.00 hours on 28th June 2021:

- (a) No entry into the fully closed section of Old Oak Common Lane;
- (b) No waiting, loading or unloading on either side of the carriageway within the fully closed section.

3. The above temporary restrictions and prohibitions will only apply at specified locations where appropriate traffic signs are provided and displayed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the Traffic Signs Manual.

4. While the temporary restrictions are in place, displaced vehicles should follow the diversions displayed in place to reach their destinations and comply with any traffic management measures.

5. This Order does not apply to:

- (a) anything done at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a police community support officer (PCSO);
- (b) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

##### Title of order

This order can be referred to as: Temporary traffic order for planned works - TT 3224 Mattock Lane, Ealing - 2021.

##### Reason for order

This order is needed to allow for works taking place on or near the road. These works involve King Lifting Ltd carrying out a crane operation in Mattock Lane at the rear of the Filmworks Development

##### Effect of order

1. Mattock Lane will be closed from its point at the rear of the Filmworks Development which is situated at the most eastern point of Mattock Lane.

#### TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC (BLYTH ROAD, CLARENDON ROAD, CLAYTON ROAD, HAYES) ORDER 2021

#### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

#### SECTION 14(1)

1. Hillingdon Council gives notice that to enable carriageway improvement works to be carried out by O'Hara Bros and to prevent the likelihood of danger to the public it intends to make this Order, which will temporarily close:

A) Blyth Road, Hayes from outside the common boundary of 23 to the junction of Clarendon Road.

B) Clarendon Road, Hayes southbound traffic only

C) Clayton Road, Hayes, from the junction of Station Road

2. Diversion route will be in place via

A) Blyth Road - Access only

B) Clarendon Road - Southbound traffic only

C) Clayton Road - Clarendon Road, Blyth Road, Dawley Road, North Hyde Road, Station Road.

Nothing in the Order shall apply to prevent vehicular access to premises on or adjacent to the prohibited length of road insofar as access is reasonably practicable without interference with the said works.

3. The temporary restriction will be in operation between 08:00hrs on the 7 July 2021 to 17:00hrs, on the 5th September 2021 and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.

Road users should assume that the closure has been put into effect only if traffic signs have been erected stating that the road has been closed and the diversion route, if necessary is in place.

4. The Order, which is proposed will come into operation on 7th July 2021, will continue in force for eighteen months or until work to which it relates is completed. However it is anticipated that the works will be completed within 61 Days.
