

Accommodation Schedule for Mother and Baby Assessment Unit

1. Entrance and Staff Office

- **Entrance and Staff Office:** Entrance and Staff Office is central point for visitors and residents, ensuring security and monitoring.
- **Waiting Area in Staff Office:** Comfortable seating for visitors, equipped with child-friendly amenities (e.g., toys, books).
- **Security Features:** Controlled access with CCTV and intercom systems.

2. Residential Accommodation

- **Individual Mother and Baby Units (x 2):**
 - 2 Bedroom with 2 separate bathrooms.
 - Space for baby cot and personal belongings.
 - Design to promote comfort and privacy.

3. Shared Living Facilities

- **Communal Lounge:** Space for social interaction and relaxation, furnished with seating, TV, and baby-safe areas.
- **Dining Area:** Shared dining space for mothers and babies to encourage communal meals.
- **Shared Kitchen:** Fully equipped kitchen with child-safe features for food preparation and cooking.

4. Assessment and Meeting Rooms (3rd room)

- **Meeting Room (x1):** Multi-purpose rooms for meetings with social workers, therapists, and family members.

5. Child Development Areas

- **Play Area:** Safe, stimulating space in the communal area for babies and toddlers, equipped with age-appropriate toys and equipment.
- **Outdoor Play Area:** Secure garden or courtyard with shaded areas, soft flooring, and play structures.

7. Staff Facilities

- **Staff Office:** Administrative space for on-site staff, in the communal area.

8. Utility and Ancillary Spaces

- **Laundry Area (in kitchen)** With washing machines, dryers, and storage for cleaning supplies.
- **Closet (Staff Office):** Equipped for cleaning and maintenance needs.

9. Accessibility Features

- House layout over ground floor, no other floors, which allows for better accessibility.
- Doorways for stroller access.
- Accessible bathrooms and facilities.

10. Parking and Transport

- On-site parking for staff and visitors
- Bicycle storage and proximity to public transport links.

11. Security and Safety

- Controlled access to the building.
- Emergency exits and fire safety equipment.
- Secure storage for hazardous materials and medicines.
