**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
THE A312 GLA ROAD (THE PARKWAY AND CHURCH ROAD,
LONDON BOROUGH OF HILLINGDON AND EALING)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2014**

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable to carriageway resurfacing and safety improvement works to take place at A312 Church Road and The Parkway.
- The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from
 - entering, exiting or proceeding in either directions on the service road fronting Nos. 406 to 500 Church Road between its junctions with the eastern and western arms of Langtry Road;
 - entering, exiting or proceeding in either direction on A312 Church Road between its junctions with Target Roundabout and White Hart Roundabout. Residential access will be maintained;
 - proceeding in a north westerly direction on the western arm of Willow Tree Lane between its junctions with A312 Willow Tree Roundabout and Hammet Close;
 - proceeding in a south easterly direction on the eastern arm of Willow Tree Lane between its junctions with A312 Willow Tree Roundabout and Glencoe Road. Residential access will be maintained;
 - proceeding in either direction on A312 The Parkway between its junctions with Ossie Garvin Roundabout and White Hart Roundabout;
 - proceeding in a northerly direction on the northern arm of Glencoe Road between its junction with the eastern arm of Willow Tree Lane and a point 100 metres north of that junction. Local access will be maintained.

The Order will be effective at certain times between 10th February 2014 and 30th April 2014 each day from 9:30 AM to 5:30 PM for article 3 (1) above only and between 10th February 2014 and 30th April 2014 every night from 9:30 PM to 5:30 AM for all articles above, or when the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner.

The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via: (for the closure of the Church Road service road) Church Road northbound, reverse course at White Hart Roundabout, Church Road southbound, reverse course at White Hart Roundabout and Church Road northbound to normal route of travel, (for the closure of Church Road) Western Avenue, West End Road and Ruislip Road or the reverse to normal route of travel, (for the closure of The Parkway and the closure of the western arm of Willow Tree Lane) Uxbridge Road and Yeading Lane or the reverse to normal route of travel, (for the closure of the eastern arm of Willow Tree Lane) Glencoe Road, Broadmead Road and Ruislip Road or the reverse to normal route of travel, (for the closure of the northern arm of Glencoe Road) The Parkway northbound, Ruislip Road, Broadmead Road and Glencoe Road to normal route of travel.
