Details of the pre-application advice received
Pre-application advice was sought for a scheme incorporating an industrial/ and logistics warehouse building scheme, providing a total of 4no individual units for Classes B2, B8 and/or E(g)(ii)/(iii) totalling 8,563 sqm.
Within the pre-application feedback the principle of the proposed land uses was supported, with the Council acknowledging in their pre-application response that planning policy encourages the redevelopment of previously developed land, and that industrial uses would be appropriate in this location.
The design and layout of the scheme was generally supported, subject to the use of appropriate materials and the impact of development on neighbouring residential properties. In particular it was recommended that careful consideration is should be given to the materials used to break up the bulk, scale and massing of the elevations.
The landscaping buffer proposed to the edges of the site was welcomed, particularly along the western boundary to separate the proposed industrial use from the residential properties in Sipson Way. However, it was also stated that the Ccouncil would like to see some hardstanding within the site layout broken up with additional soft landscaping, to provide a softer setting to the industrial type buildings.
Concerns were raised regarding the ongoing maintenance of the access bridge from the RaddisonRadisson Hotel and Conference Centre. However, based on subsequent correspondence it is understood that the bridge is adopted highway. The highway authority is therefore responsible for the maintenance of this bridge.
The Ccouncil recommended that further technical information should be provided to demonstrate that the proposal would not result in any unacceptable harm to the light and outlook of neighbouring properties, and that there would be no unacceptable harm in terms of noise impact and air quality.
The acceptability of the scheme was also subject to further technical information being provided, demonstrating that the scheme was satisfactory with regards to transport, sustainability, ecology, flood risk, contamination and fire safety.
