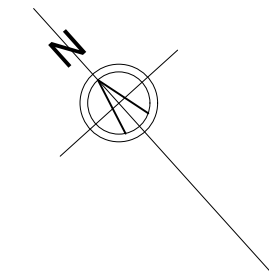


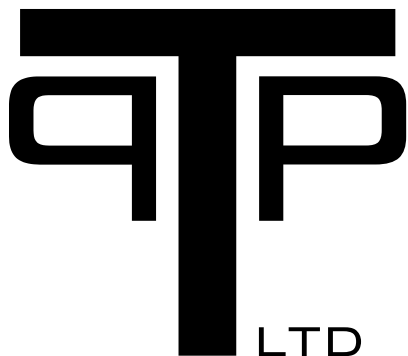
EXISTING GROUND FLOOR LAYOUT (1:50)

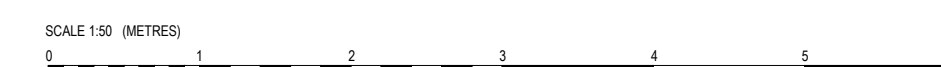
