- The London Borough of Hounslow hereby gives Notice that in connection with statutory works to be carried out in Bell Road, Hounslow, it has made an Order the effect of which will be to:
 - prohibit vehicles from proceeding in the length of Bell Road which lies between the south-eastern kerb-line of Grove Road and the common boundary of Nos. 34 and 36 Bell Road; and
 - suspend the operation of the existing loading bay on the north-east side of Bell Road, outside Nos. 38 and 40 Bell Road.

 - any vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
 - anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or an accredited person; or
 - emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
- Traffic will be diverted via Grove Road, Staines Road, Wellington Road South, Hanworth Road and Bell Road or via Grove Road, Hanworth Road, Kingsley Road, Spring Grove Road, Lampton Road, Bath Road, Wellington Road North and Staines Road.
