Introduction

Progress Planning, as Multi-disciplined Consultants, have been asked to prepare a statement and commentary in relation to compliance with London Policy D12.

Fire safety information will be passed to the end user through the management of the building so that they fully understand the fire safety measures provided as part of the existing building.

The fire strategy follows the existing use of the site, as the proposal is for the change of use and does not intensify the use it is considered adequate.
