CONDITION 3. MATERIALS

Roof Tiles: Dreadnought Clay Tile (Staffordshire Blue).

Facing Brick: Michelmersh (Freshfield Lane, Selected Dark).

Detail Brick: Michelmersh (Freshfield Lane, Selected Light).

Stone: Portland.

Dormer Cheeks: Lead (Grey).

Front Door – Timber (Dark Grey).

Windows and Doors – Aluminium Frame (Dark Grey).

Fascia Boards and Soffits – Timber (Dark Grey).

Secondary Fascia – GRP (colour to match stone colour).

Rainwater Pipes and Gutters – Aluminium (Dark Grey).

Paths and Patios – Paving Slab (Light Grey / Off White).

Driveway – Permeable Resin Bound Gravel (Light Grey).

Proposed roof tile, facing brick, driveway and paving images provided over leaf.
