



- A** Existing tarmac parking court
- B** Existing Cypress hedge units circa 1.8m spacings to allow permeability through fence-line
- C** Proposed 2m high instant ivy screen
- D** 11x11m garden pergola with living meadow roof. Total height circa 2.8m (2.2m internal + 500-600mm structural build-up)
- E** Narrow crown evergreen trees that are beneficial for wildlife eg Oak leaf Holly, set within woodland associated low planting eg ferns, eg Ferns, Hostas, Fox gloves and Anemones (High pollinating for wildlife)
- F** Existing mature trees retained. New under planting - Tough ground covers eg vinca minor
- G** Brick and clay pavers - Sympathetic choice of materials which compliment existing Architecture
- H** Stone paved areas high quality eg york stone
- I** Artificial grass removed and replaced with new stone paving eg yorkstone around existing water foundation. Gate way arch retained
- J** New garden with managed lawn and lush verdant planting to boundaries. Western Boundary to include native planting and more silver birch trees
- K** Existing sheds
- L** Gravelled area
- M** Pyracantha hedge - Evergreen/berries for wildlife
- A:** Tarmac surfaces
- B:** Clay/brick pavers
- C:** Stone paving eg yorkstone
- D:** Gravelled surfaces
- E:** New shrub and herbaceous planting. High pollinators to be introduced to mixes
- F:** Hedge planting maintained at height of fence eg 1.8m high
- G:** Grass lawn
- H:** Biodiverse meadow roofs
- I:** Proposed trees
- J:** Existing trees retained
