Application to fell a tree at 37 St Martins Approach, Ruislip, HA4 7QH

Planning statement

This application seeks to fell a tree located at the rear of 37 St Martins approach and marked on the accompanying plans as T006.

The tree suffers from progressing decay as evidenced by a tree report and a resistograph test submitted as part of this application.

The level of decay means that the tree poses a potential threat of uncontrolled collapse. Being located close to the houses at nos 35 and 37 St Martins Approach this translates to real hazard to both people and property.

The tree in question is listed in council's TPO.

The site at no.37 contains two more, larger trees protected by TPO as well as extensive planting including smaller trees and numerous shrubs.

As such, the loss of a single tree is deemed to have minimal environmental and visual effect as demonstrated on the photographs in the further part of this document.
