The proposed site is situated on the northern edge of the existing car park at Goals Soccer Centre, positioned on the soft landscaping near the T-junction of Springfield Road and Loverose Way.







Our initial design approach was to show the container on site and the general layout of the internal space.




Initial Sketch Design and Sun Path




Initial General layout Plan




Proposed Site Plan

5.0 Energy & Sustainability

Low impact in construction

Every effort will be made to reduce the impact of materials and products used in the construction.

Any surplus material that is produced on site will be carefully managed and segregated in skips for off-site recycling. The Site Manager will have overall responsibility to ensure that construction is carried out in accordance with best practice and with the aim of achieving as close to Zero Waste to Landfill as possible.

Materials and services will be sourced locally where possible with any timber sourced from sustainable managed forests. All insulation will CFC and HCFC free, with water based paints used where possible, and any coating and preservative treatments factory applied wherever possible.

Low energy in use

The buildings external envelope will be highly insulated and detailed to minimise air leakage.

The design has been optimized for excellent daylight levels within the container, while low energy LED lighting will be provided.

6.0 Access

The proposed design will not disturb the arrangement of the existing on-site parking spaces. No further parking spaces will be required.

7.0 Summary

The application seeks planning consent to establish a food hut on the northern edge of the existing car park at Goals Soccer Centre, near the T-junction of Springfield Road and Loverose Way. The proposal includes a food hut, external bin stores, and a storage container, designed to enhance the site's amenities.

The food hut aims to meet high visitor demand by offering convenient, on-the-go dining options. Supported by the Goals Soccer Centre, the initiative is expected to add value to the site, increase footfall, and improve the overall visitor experience.

Subject to consent the scheme will be designed to comply with the latest edition of the Building Regulations.


