

01 - FRONT ELEVATION



This architectural drawing illustrates a brick extension to an existing house. The extension is a single-story gabled structure with a brick facade. A chimney is located at the apex of the roof. The roof is covered with new roof tiles, which are specified to match the existing tiles. The drawing shows the brickwork of the extension and the original house matching. A dimension line indicates a width of 1.0 M for the extension. A note specifies that the value of the chimney should be projected not more than 100 mm from the roof. A note also specifies that brickwork should be done to match the existing brickwork.


