REFUSAL OF PLANNING PERMISSION

Ref: 60361/APP/2005/695

- The proposed single storey extension, by virtue of its wrap around appearance, will be detrimental to the architectural composition of the existing building and will harm the character and appearance of the street scene. The proposal is therefore contrary to Policies BE13, BE15 and BE19 of the Borough's adopted Unitary Development.
- 2. The proposed parapet wall of the extension, by reason of its overall height, length of projection and proximity to the adjoining property at No.2 Myrtle Close, is considered to represent an unneighbourly form of development, detrimental to the residential amenity of this property by reason of loss of outlook. The proposal is therefore contrary to Policies BE20 and BE21 of the Borough's adopted Unitary Development.
