Frequently asked questions

What's a kWh?

kWh (kilowatt-hour) is the unit used to measure energy use. 1 kWh will power a 40 watt light bulb for 25 hours.

What is the price made up of?

The price of your energy is split into two parts.

- The standing charge - this is a set amount per day
- And the energy you use - this is worked out by multiplying the unit rate (the amount you pay for energy per kilowatt-hour) by the amount of energy you've used

That means the minimum you'll pay is the standing charge, even if you don't use any gas or electricity. You then pay for what you use (it's similar to the line rental for your phone). What happens if I change the way I pay?

Customers who pay by Direct Debit are charged a lower price than customers who pay by cash or cheque. As a Direct Debit customer our standing charge for electricity will be 26.01p per day and our unit rate will be 16.53 pence/kWh. These prices include VAT. You can also see the difference between our prices at [britishgas.co.uk/alltariffs](https://www.britishgas.co.uk/alltariffs). You can set up a Direct Debit online or by calling us on 0333 202 9802*. If you set up a Direct Debit then change back to cash or cheque, your prices will go up. If you set up a Direct Debit and then miss your payments, we can ask you to pay by cash or cheque and your prices will go up. We'll write to you at least seven working days before changing the way you pay.


