Tree T1 Oak (*Quercus robur*)

Approx. Diameter at 1.5m - 0.5-0.75m

Approx. Height - 15m

Approx. Crown Spread Diameter - 12m

Location - Rear garden near house left hand side

crown reduce the side which overhangs the clients patio area only by removing between 1.5-2.5m.

Remove major deadwood of more than 50mm in diameter and greater than 0.5m in length

Reason - to reduce the amount of tree litter continuously dropping onto the clients patio area resulting in ongoing maintenance and repair

Tree T2 Oak (*Quercus robur*)

Approx. Diameter at 1.5m - 0.5-0.75m

Approx. Height - 15m

Approx. Crown Spread Diameter - 12m

Location - Rear garden near house right hand side

crown reduce the side which overhangs the clients patio area only by removing between 1.5-2.5m.

Remove major deadwood of more than 50mm in diameter and greater than 0.5m in length

Reason - to reduce the amount of tree litter As T1

Tree T4 Ivy clad Hornbeam (*Carpinus betulus*)

Approx. Diameter at 1.5m - 0.3-0.5m

Approx. Height - 15m

Approx. Crown Spread Diameter - 6m

Location - Rear garden left hand side

Section dismantle tree to near ground level and leave stump in ground, Treat stump with one application of glyphosate (eco-plugs) only to best endeavour the prevention of regrowth.

Reason - tree heavily ivy clad and severely leaning as compressed by surround larger trees resulting in high probability of potential failure

Tree G1 x5 Hornbeam (*Carpinus betulus*)

Approx. Diameter at 1.5m - 0.1-0.3m

Approx. Height - 12m

Approx. Crown Spread Diameter - 2-3m

Location - Rear garden left hand side

Fell as close to trees current ground level as possible and leave the stump in the ground

Reason - trees are dead, heavily leaning and some have uprooted

Tree T5 Lawson Cypress (*Chamaecyparis lawsoniana*)

Approx. Diameter at 1.5m - 0.1-0.3m

Approx. Height - 7m

Approx. Crown Spread Diameter - 4m

Location - Rear garden left hand side

Fell as close to trees current ground level as possible and leave the stump in the ground

Reason - small tree, to remove added competition to the surrounding more mature oaks and hornbeam trees

Tree T6 Yew (*taxus baccatta*)

Approx. Diameter at 1.5m - below 75mm

Approx. Height - 5m

Approx. Crown Spread Diameter - 3m

Location - Rear garden Right hand boundary

Fell as close to trees current ground level as possible and leave the stump in the ground

Reason - small tree, to remove added competition to the surrounding more mature oaks and hornbeam

Tree G2 x3 Hornbeam (*Carpinus betulus*)

Approx. Diameter at 1.5m - 0.1-0.3m

Approx. Height - 12-15m

Approx. Crown Spread Diameter - 3-6m

Location - Rear garden right hand side

Section dismantle trees as close to current ground level as possible and leave the stump in the ground

Reason - trees are severely leaning as compressed by surround larger trees resulting in high probability of potential failure, the largest diameter tree has mass decay at its base

You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.

e.g. Oak (T3) – Whole crown reduction to 12m above ground level, to provide sufficient clearance to property.

Sketch plan requirements

Your plan needs to show the precise location of the tree(s) in relation to nearby property/roads/boundaries. It should, therefore:

- indicate the main features of the site where the tree(s) stand and its surroundings; in particular, you should:
 - mark and name surrounding roads
 - sketch in buildings, including adjoining properties
 - add house numbers or names
- mark the position of the tree(s) to which you want to carry out work and identify them by the number shown in the Tree Preservation Order where possible; if you use a different number, please make sure that this can be matched with your description of the tree(s)
- if there are many trees on the site, make clear which tree(s) are included in this application by:
 - marking all trees on the plan, but only numbering those to which you want to carry out work
 - showing the approximate distance between the application tree(s) and buildings
 - adding other relevant features on the site (e.g. greenhouse, paths)

If it is impossible to identify the tree(s) accurately on the plan (e.g. because they are part of a woodland or group of trees), please identify their approximate location on the plan and provide details of how the tree(s) are marked on site (e.g. high visibility tape, tree tags, paint, etc); trees must not be marked by scarring or cutting into the bark.
