

PROPOSAL
Tree Application for No1 Deborah Crescent

The Oak T3 on TPO307 is situated in the rear garden of No1 Deborah Crescent, it is just 9m from the rear elevation of the property, and a similar distance from No1 Vicarage Close (see att sketch SK1) Branches closely approach the rear elevations of the properties at No1 Deborah Crescent, No2 Deborah Crescent and No1 Vicarage Close. Both neighbours have complained repeatedly.

There are three particular boughs that require attention, one of which is forked.

Specifically one inbound bough forks and:

- a/ Overhangs the rear elevation of No1 Deborah Crescent and shadows the windows.
- b/ Crosses the boundary with No2 Deborah Crescent, overhangs the rear extension and shadows the windows.

A second inbound bough again overhangs the rear elevation of No1 Deborah Crescent and shadows the windows.

A third outbound bough crosses the rear boundary and overhangs the rear elevation of No1 Vicarage Close overshadowing the windows.

It is proposed to reduce each of these boughs by approximately 2m to the nearest suitable junction. In order to retain the form and appearance of the Crown, adjacent foliage will be trimmed to suit. Any such trimming will be minimal to preserve the overall esthetics of the tree.
