The condition is sought to be varied to regularise a minor dimensional discrepancy between the approved plans and the development as constructed.

The variation relates to a slight reduction in the separation distance between the side elevation of the extension and the boundary. This change is minimal in scale and does not result in any material impact on neighbouring amenity, including loss of light, outlook, or sense of enclosure.

The overall form, scale and design of the extension remain consistent with the approved scheme, and the development continues to comply with the relevant planning policies and design principles.

The amendment is therefore considered to be minor in nature and acceptable in planning terms.
