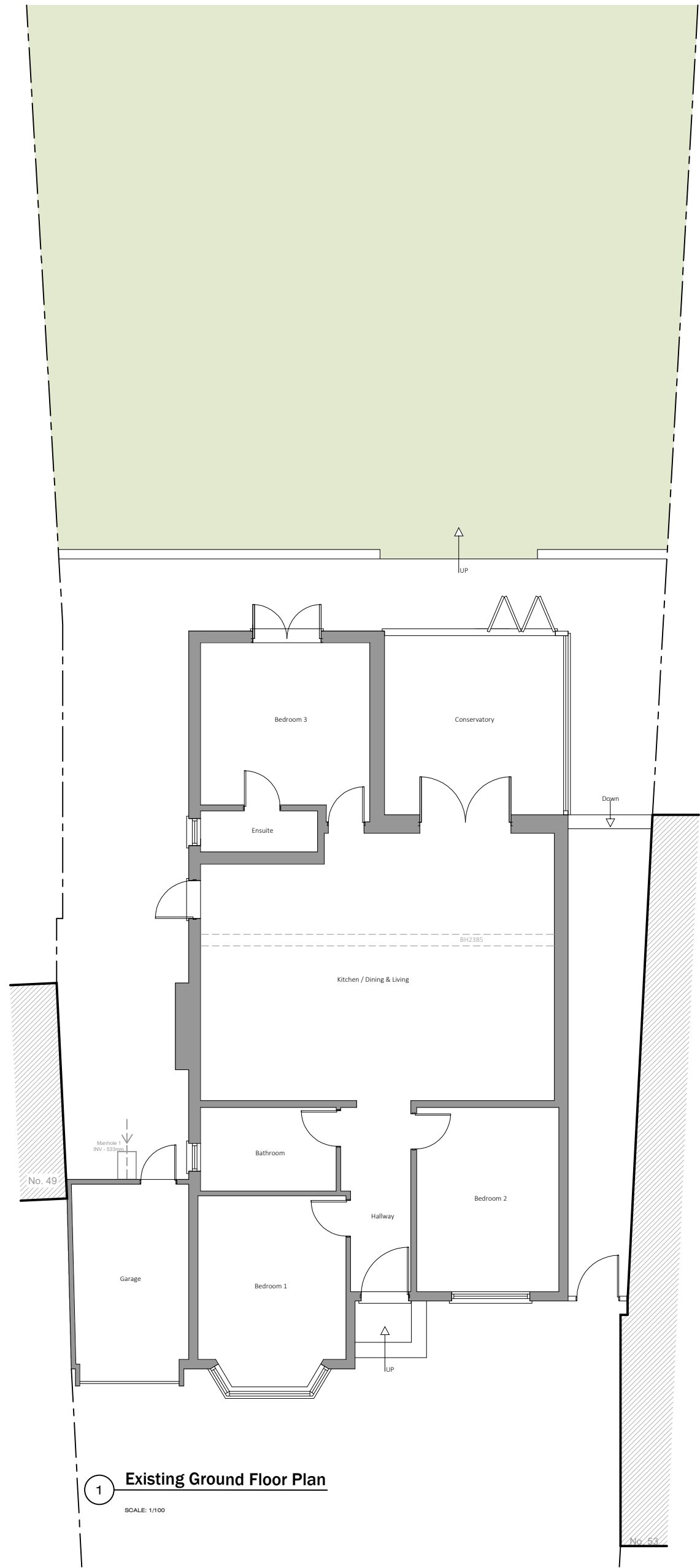
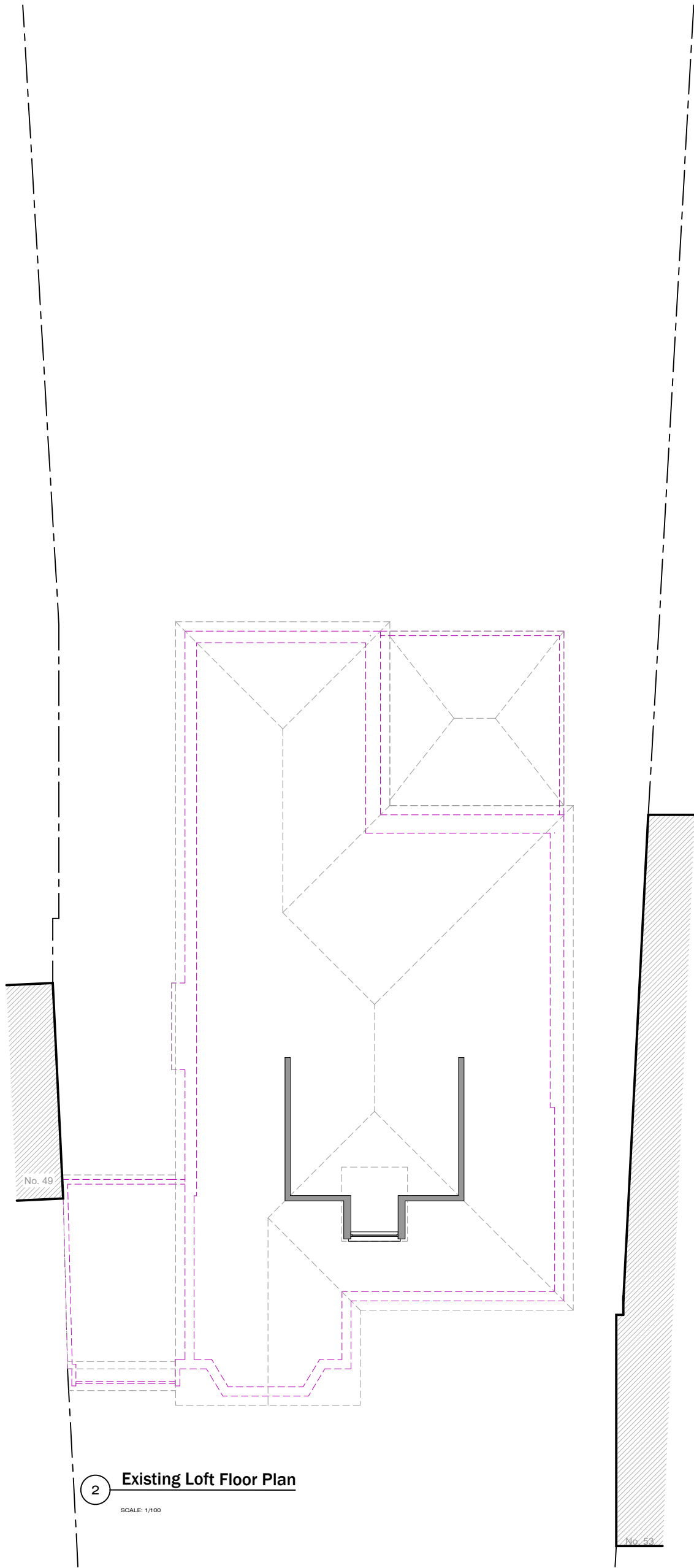
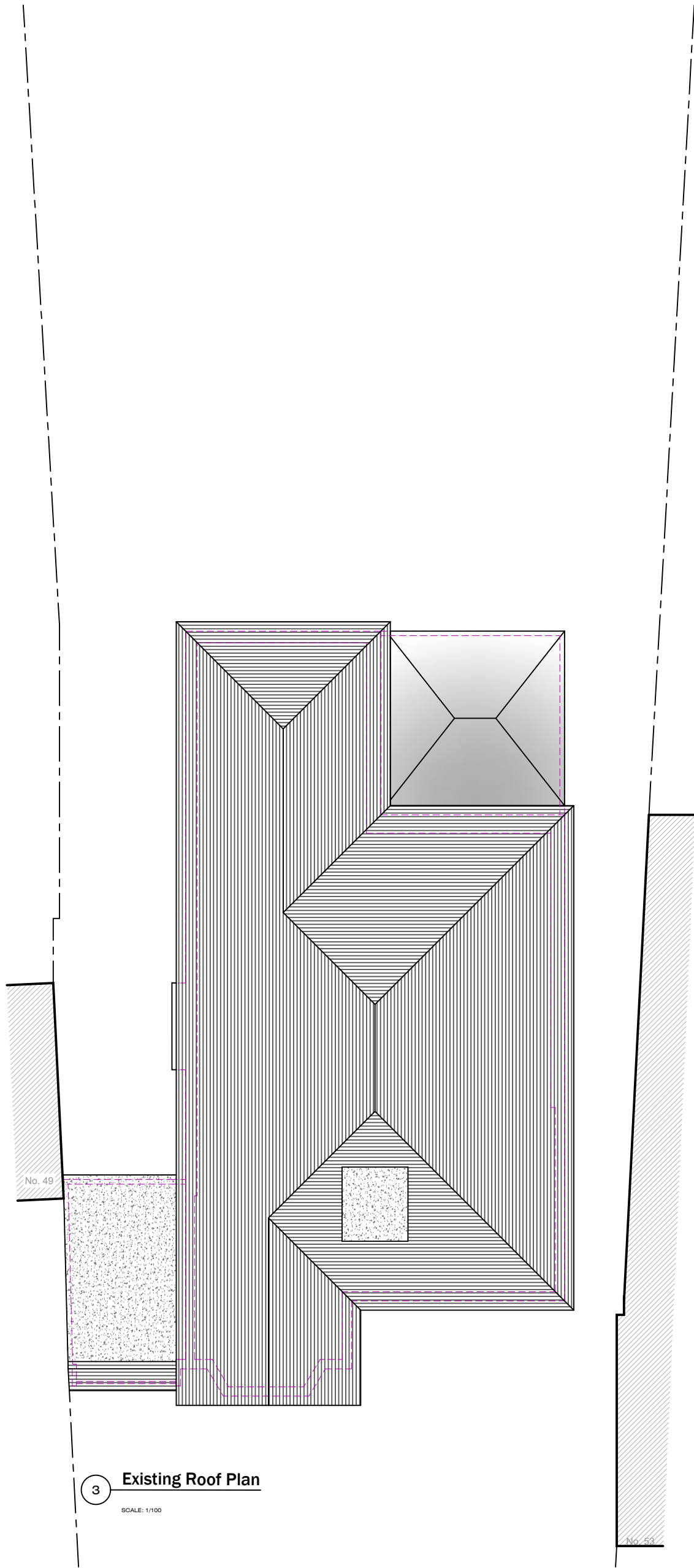




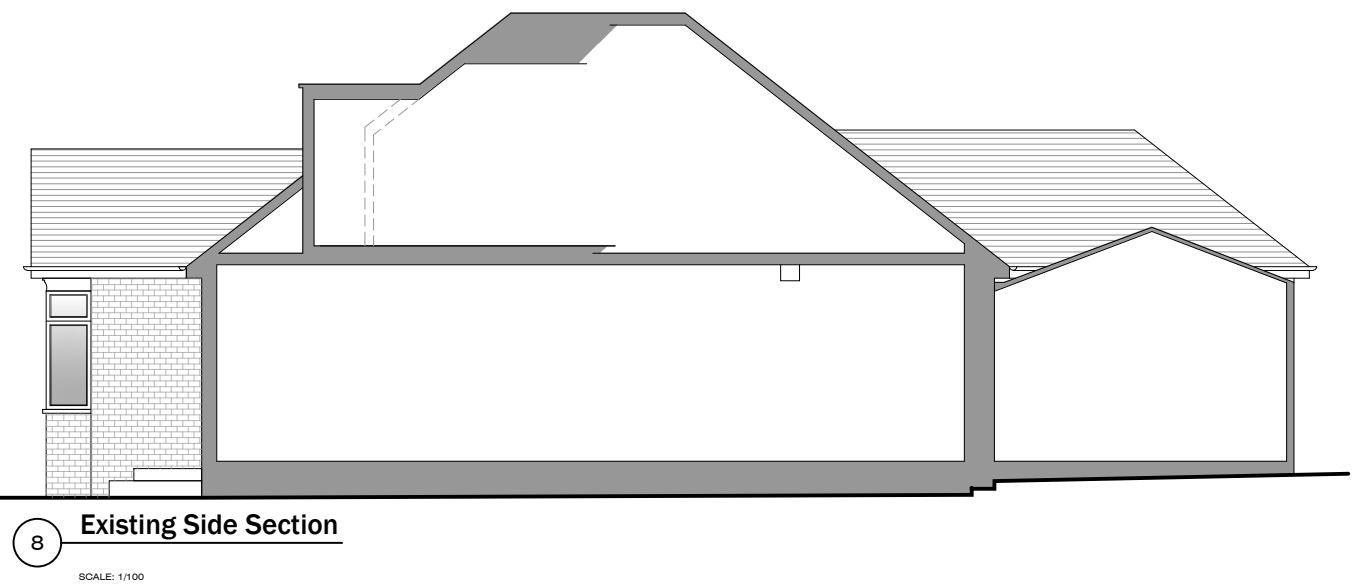
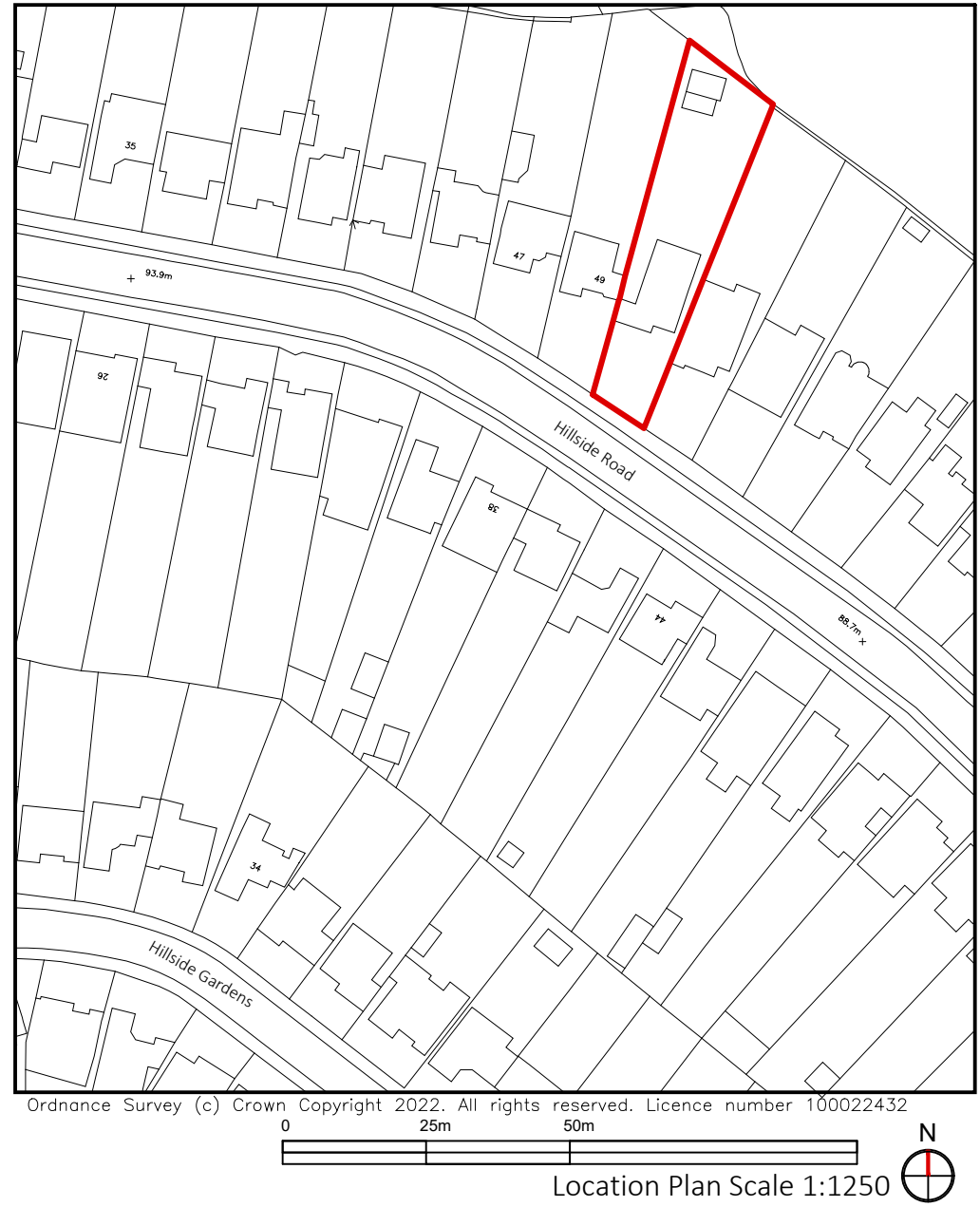
1 Existing Ground Floor Plan



2 Existing Loft Floor Plan



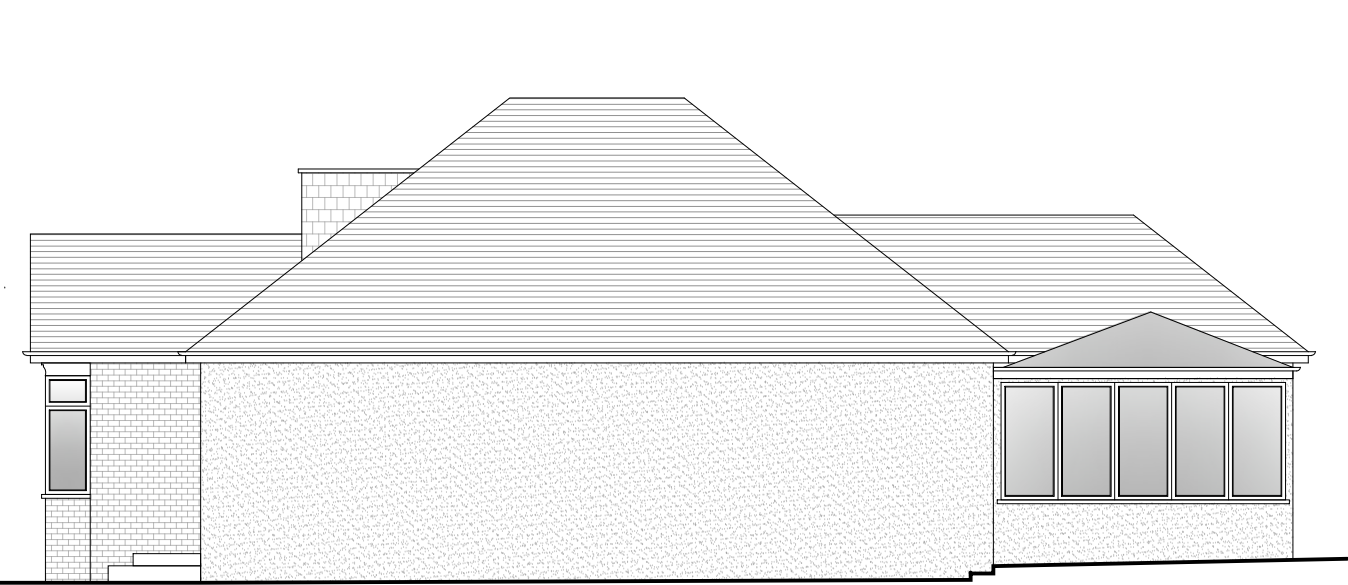
3 Existing Roof Plan



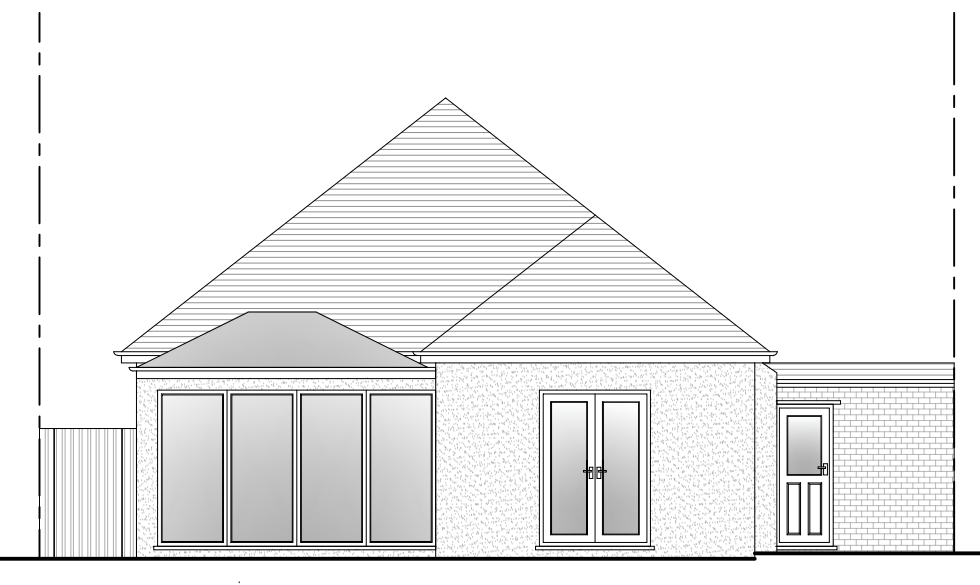
8 Existing Side Section

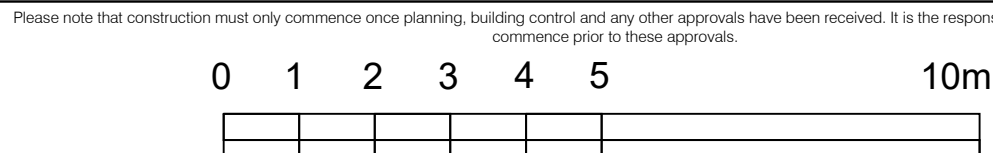
