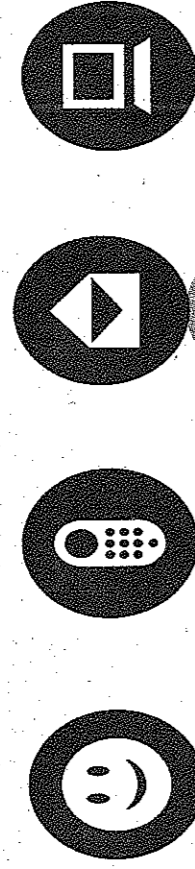

Hillingdon Council gives notice that it made these experimental Orders under Section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on 22nd July 2016 coming into operation on 8th August 2016, which will:

1. Replace the existing disabled parking bays in the section of St Anselm's Road, Hayes opposite Nos. 2 and 4 with Monday to Saturday 8am to 6.30pm Pay & Display parking bays (with charges as shown below).
2. Impose 'at any time' loading restrictions on all existing double yellow lines in the section of St Anselm's Road, Hayes near The Parish Church of St Anselm.

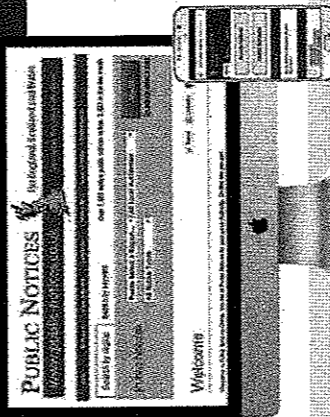
