I believe the tree is a Scotts pine. It has grown to a very tall height which in itself poses a concern around health and safety and potential damage to my property is substantial. However, for this application I would like to cut back 2/3 branches that are low and overhanging into my boundary.

Again, main reason to cut back is health and safety of the branches that could break off and fall onto my vehicle or children or myself.

These 2/3 branches should not damage or impact the tree but will prevent hundreds of pine cones and sap damaging my driveway and car as well.

The 2/3 branches will be cut back approximately 2 metres so can be seen as pruning rather than destroying or damaging the tree.


