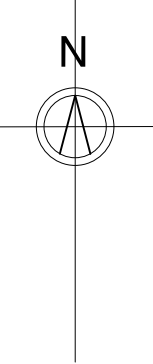

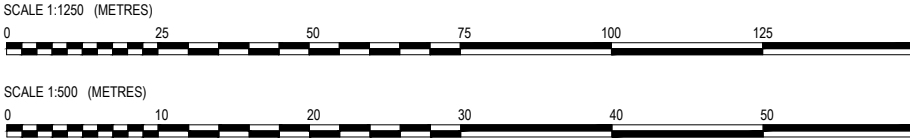
PROPOSED BLOCK PLAN (1:500)

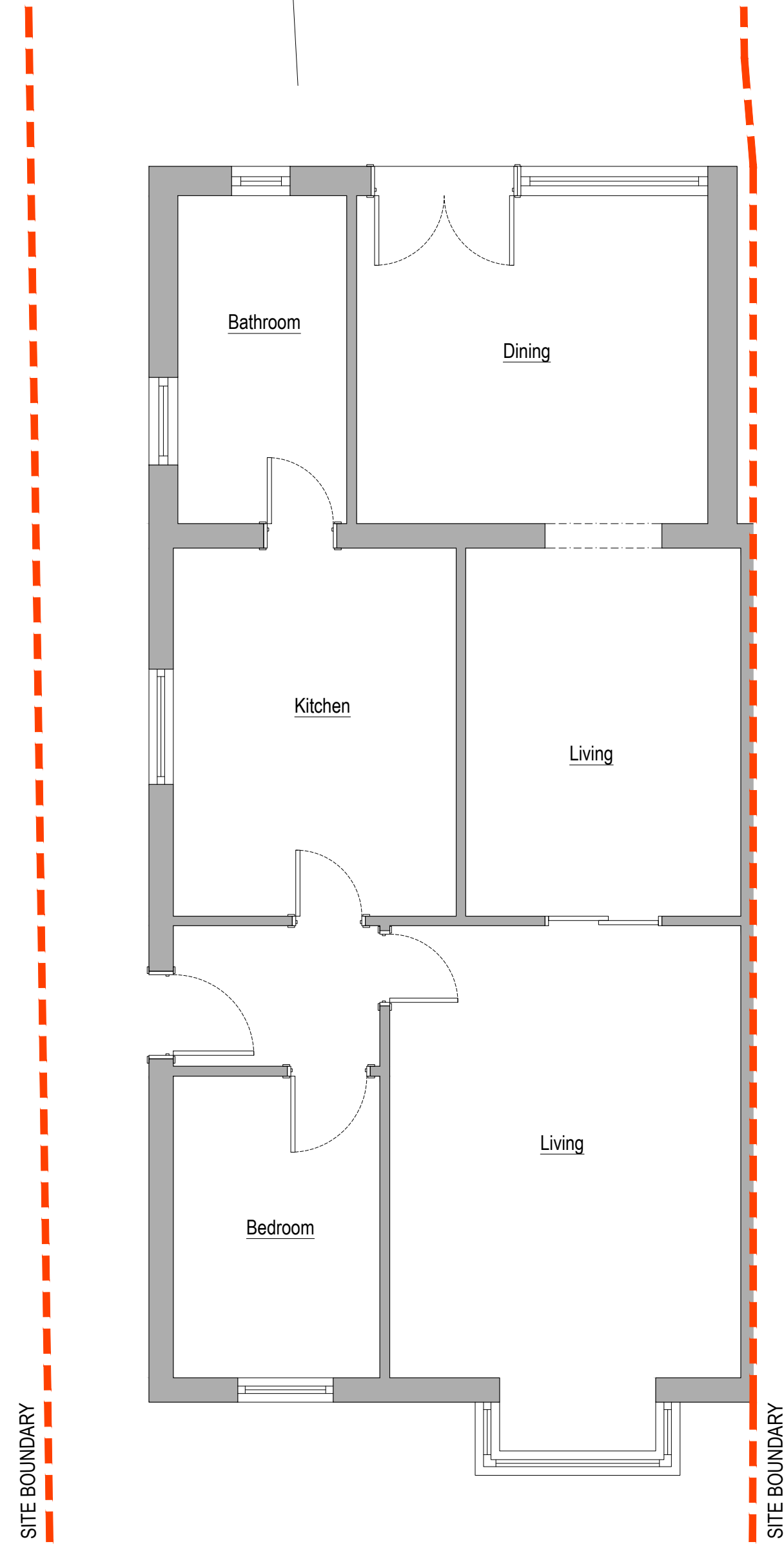


SITE LOCATION PLAN (1:1250)
