**Re: Land at 75a Bridge Road (the subject site)**

Thank you for your request for information via our online Contaminated Land enquiry system.

In response to your question which asks "*Are there any land contamination risks on this site?*" I have now conducted a search of the Council's available records concerning Contaminated Land / Land Affected by Contamination.

The Council's GIS Mapping system identifies land at property as having a "Former Land use described as: *Works (Various)*"

Photographic evidence shows signage above the undercroft access which leads to the subject site. The sign clearly indicates a business named "Craftsman Springs" has occupied the subject site.

It is understood the business activities include design and manufacture of extension, compression and torsion springs, formed from a variety of metals.

However, our records do not contain any site-specific information concerning land condition or risks that may be associated with any contamination that may be present at the subject site.

In the meantime, I can confirm the subject site is not included on the Council's current Site Prioritisation List, which is produced in accordance with the London Borough of Hillingdon Contaminated Land Inspection Strategy.

I trust the above information will be suitable for your requirements.
