LONDON BOROUGH OF HAMMERSMITH AND FULHAM ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1) (VANSTON PLACE AND JERDAN PLACE) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

1. The Council of the London Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham hereby gives notice that in order to facilitate crane works in the above-named road; it made an Order the effect of which will temporarily prohibit traffic in a section of the above-named roads.
2. Whilst works are in progress, or whilst the authorised traffic signs are displayed:
 - (i) no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter, stop, wait, load or proceed in:
 - a) Jerdan Place, the south-eastern arm, between Fulham Road / Broadway and Vanston Place;
 - b) Vanston Place, adjacent to No. 20 Fulham Broadway; no person or vehicle shall enter, stop, wait, load or proceed in that part of the footway in Vanston Place, the south-west side, adjacent to No. 20 Fulham Broadway;
 - (ii) the one way working in Vanston Place, between its junction with Jerdan Place (south-eastern arm) and Fulham Road / Broadway, would be temporarily suspended so that traffic would be permitted to travel two ways in that section of Vanston Place; and
 - (iii) the loading bays in:
 - (a) Jerdan Place, the south-eastern arm; and
 - (b) Vanston Place, opposite No. 45 Fulham Broadway; would be suspended.
3. An alternative route for:
 - (i) vehicular traffic in article 2 shall be provided via Fulham Broadway and Jerdan Place; and
 - (ii) pedestrian traffic in article 2(ii) shall be provided via the north-eastern footway in Vanston Place.
4. Exemptions will be provided in the Order to permit reasonable access to premises, so far as it is practical without interference with the execution of the said work and for works vehicles, any vehicle being used in connection with police, fire or ambulance purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
5. The Order will come into operation on the 19th November 2021 and will be valid for a maximum period of 18 months or until works are completed, whichever is the sooner.
6. Works will be expected to commence on Friday 19th November 2021 and last for 7 days. The dates specified are for guidance and informative purposes only and works may extend outside these dates.

LONDON BOROUGH OF EALING NOTICE OF MAKING OF TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDER FOR PLANNED WORKS AFFECTING: MERRICK ROAD, SOUTHALL.

Ealing Council intends to make the following temporary traffic order under section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:

Title of order
This order can be referred to as: **Temporary traffic order for planned works - TT 3334 Merrick Road, Southall - 2021**

Reason for order
This order is needed to allow for works taking place on or near the road. These works involve London Tower Cranes & Nationwide Traffic Solutions carrying out a tower crane operation in Merrick Road, Southall.

Effect of order

1. Merrick Road will be closed at its point formerly Butleigh House but now Redrow Developments to place a tower crane on the public highway.
2. The following temporary restrictions on vehicle movements will take effect from 12th November 2021:
 - (a) No entry into the fully closed section of Merrick Road;
 - (b) No waiting, loading or unloading on either side of the carriageway within the fully closed section.

Title of order

This order can be referred to as: **Temporary traffic order for planned works - TT 3392 Medway Parade, Perivale - 2021.**

LONDON BOROUGH OF HILLINGDON TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC (SHEPSTON LANE, HAYES) ORDER 2022 ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1)

1. Hillingdon Council gives notice that to enable renewal works to be carried out by Affinity Water and to prevent the likelihood of danger to the public it intends to make this Order, which will temporarily close Shepston Lane, Hayes from Outside 56/58 Shepston Lane.

2. No Diversion route will be in place. Nothing in the Order shall apply to prevent vehicular access to premises on or adjacent to the prohibited length of road insofar as access is reasonably practicable without interference with the said works.

3. The temporary restriction will be in operation between 08:00hrs on the 4th January 2022 to 17:00hrs, on the 17th January 2022 and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

Road users should assume that the closure has been put into effect only if traffic signs have been erected stating that the road has been closed and the diversion route, if necessary is in place.

4. The Order, which is proposed will come into operation on 4th January 2022, will continue in force for eighteen months or until work to which it relates is completed. However it is anticipated that the works will be completed within 14 Days.
