Hi Richard,

Thank you for your response and explanation. I have a couple of questions with regards to this request which I have listed below. Can you kindly provide clarifications for these?

- 1) **Scenario-1:** If we plan to install an obscure glazed "openable" side window at the level of the first floor in the staircase in the end of terrace wall (which I believe is called as side elevation) and if it is 1.7 meters "above" the stair immediately below the centre part of the opening of window (as referred in the attached picture to this email). Does this require planning permission?
- 2) **Scenario-2:** The same as scenario-1, except if we plan to install an obscure glazed "non-openable" side window, does this require planning permission?

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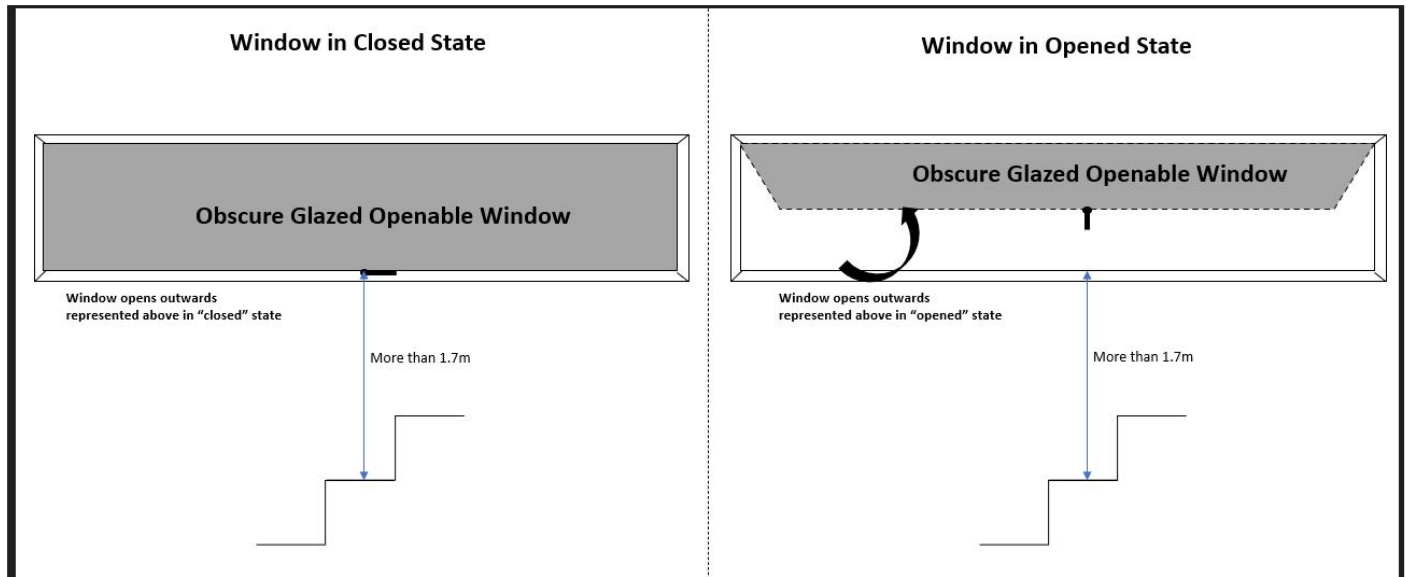
