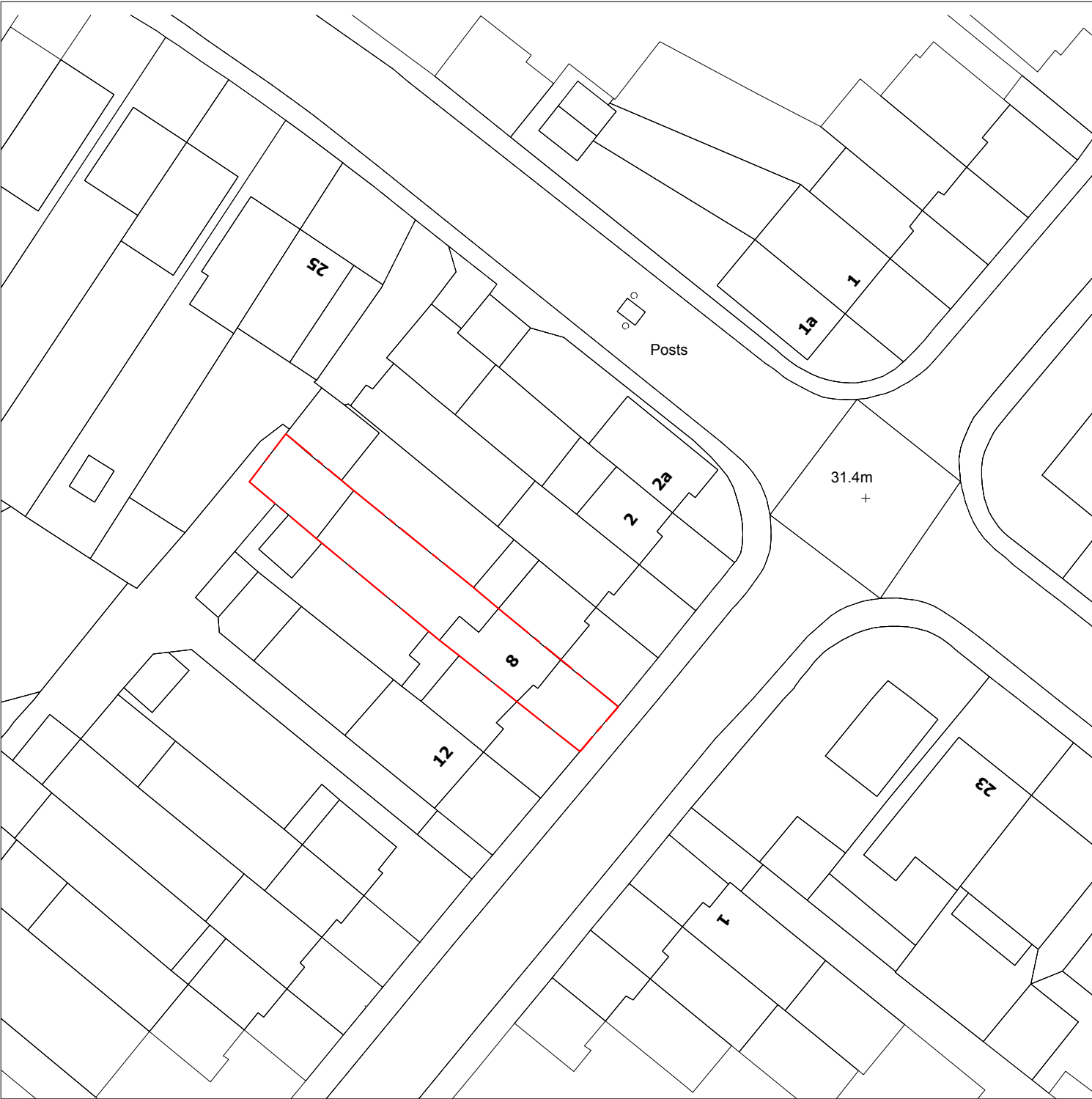

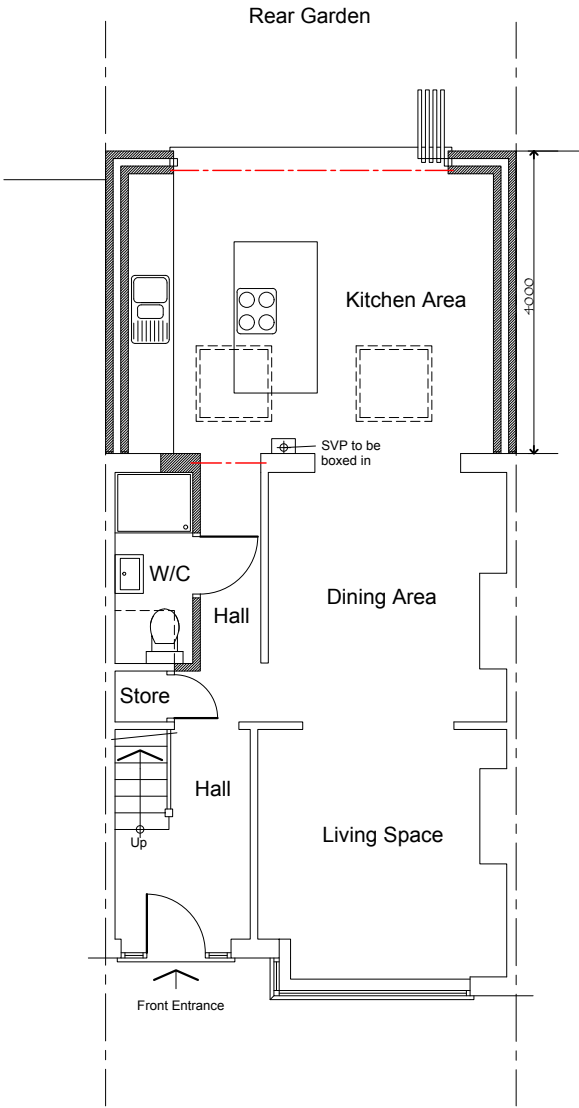
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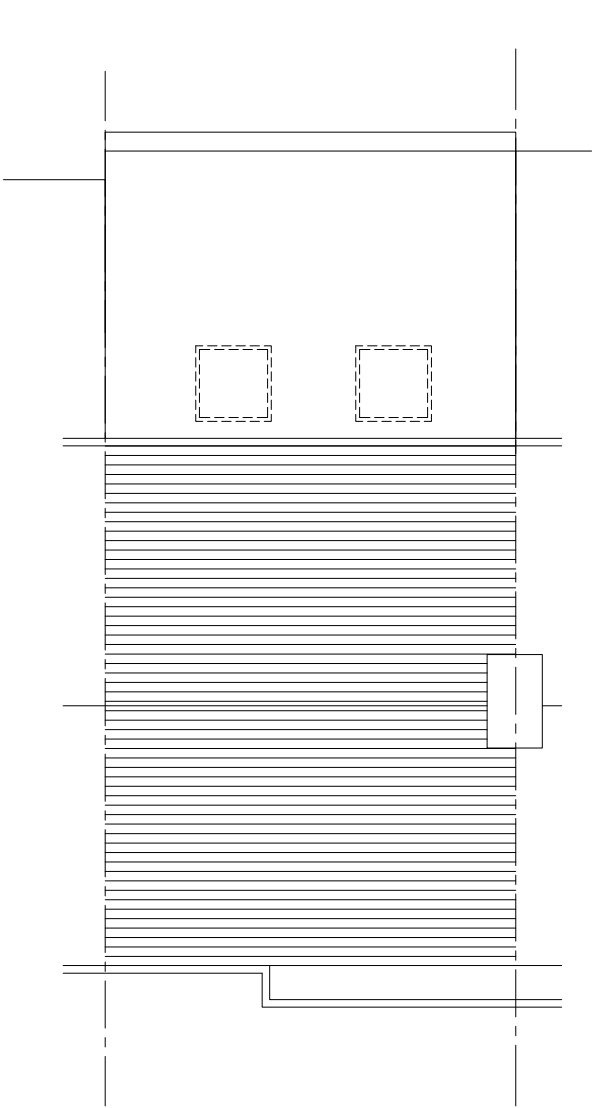
Existing Ground Floor Plan



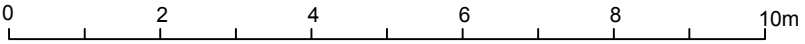
Existing Roof Plan

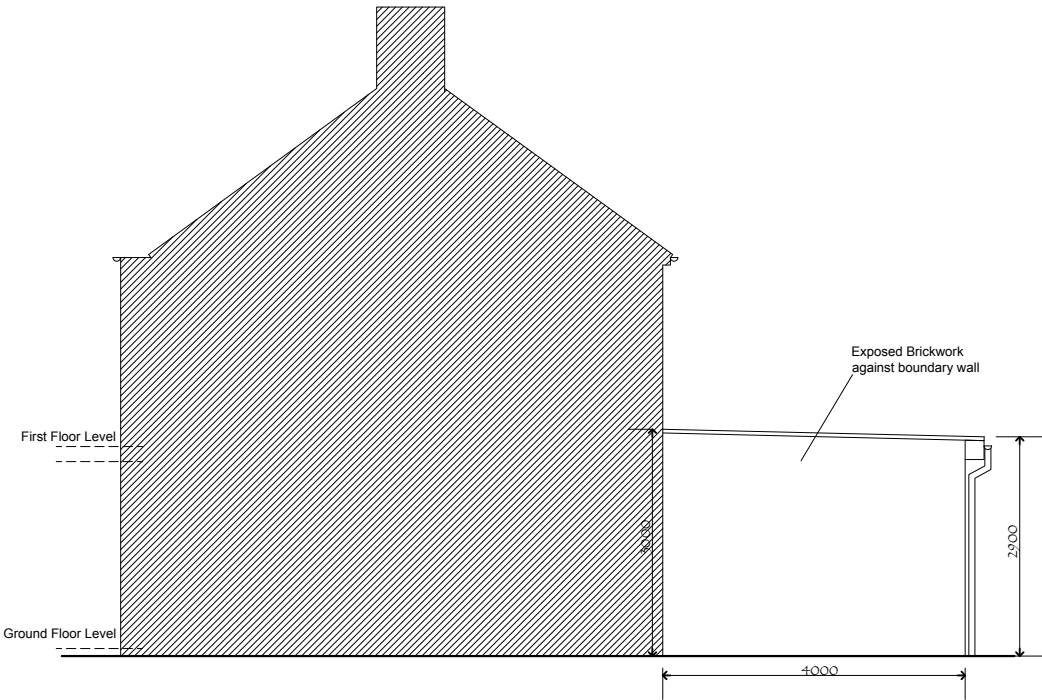
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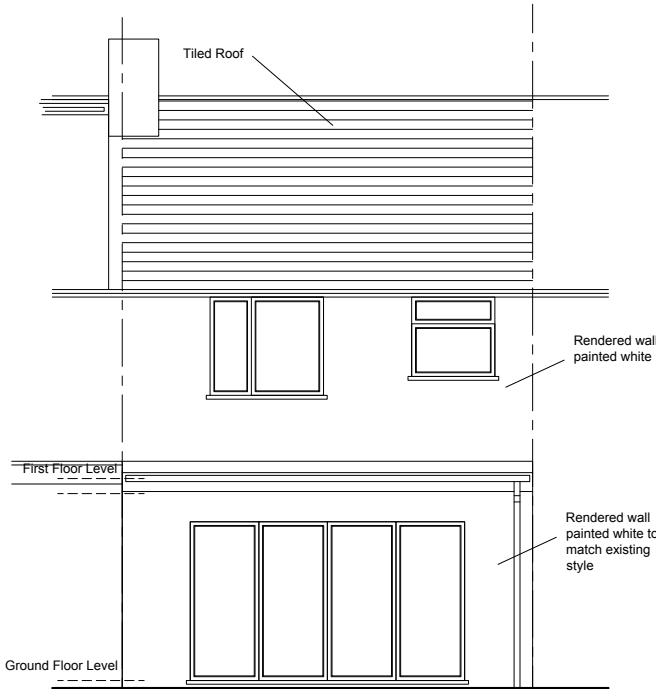
Existing Side Elevation



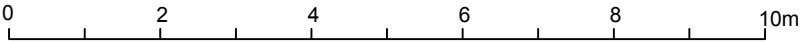
Existing Rear Elevation

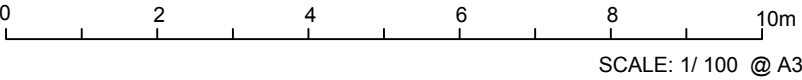

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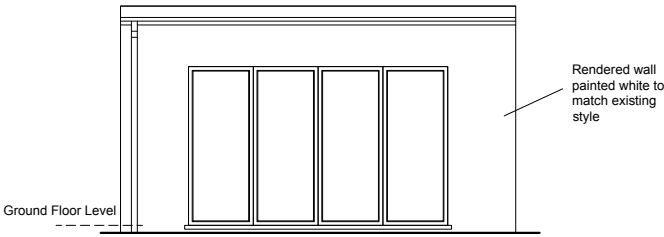
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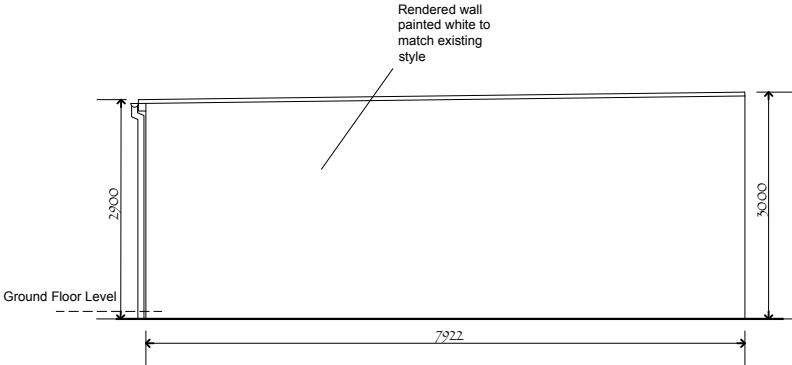
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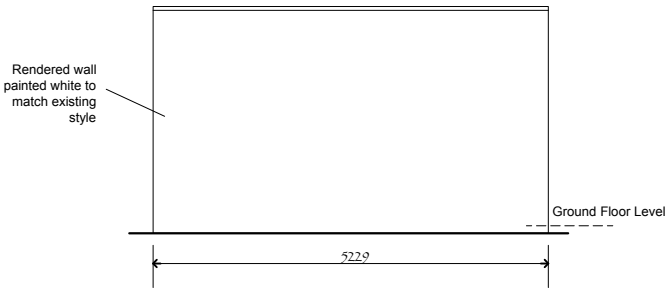
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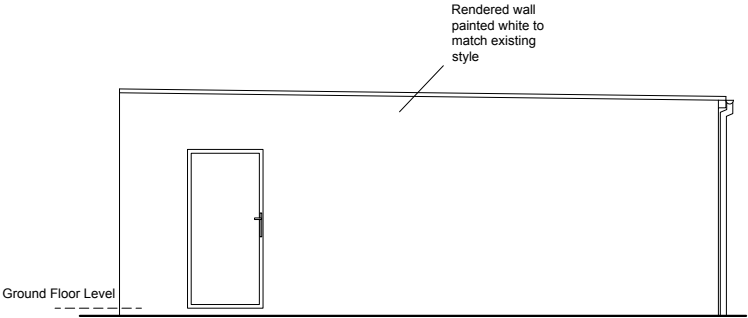
Proposed Front Elevation (1:100)



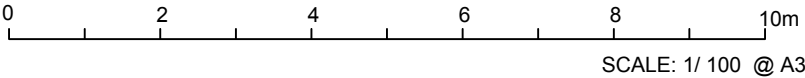
