Regarding the above. We are required to carry out essential works to the trees in TPO 351 due to their close proximity to the buildings & public walkways.

The tree works will involve cutting the trees back in height to approx. 20 meters to ensure safety to residents and visitors. The trees are identified as T13, T6, T7 and those circled in G2 (A, S, B). There are also 3 trees in the conservation area adjacent to 1-23 Amberley Way which require the same treatment, along with 3 trees behind the second block of flats on Turnpike Lane.

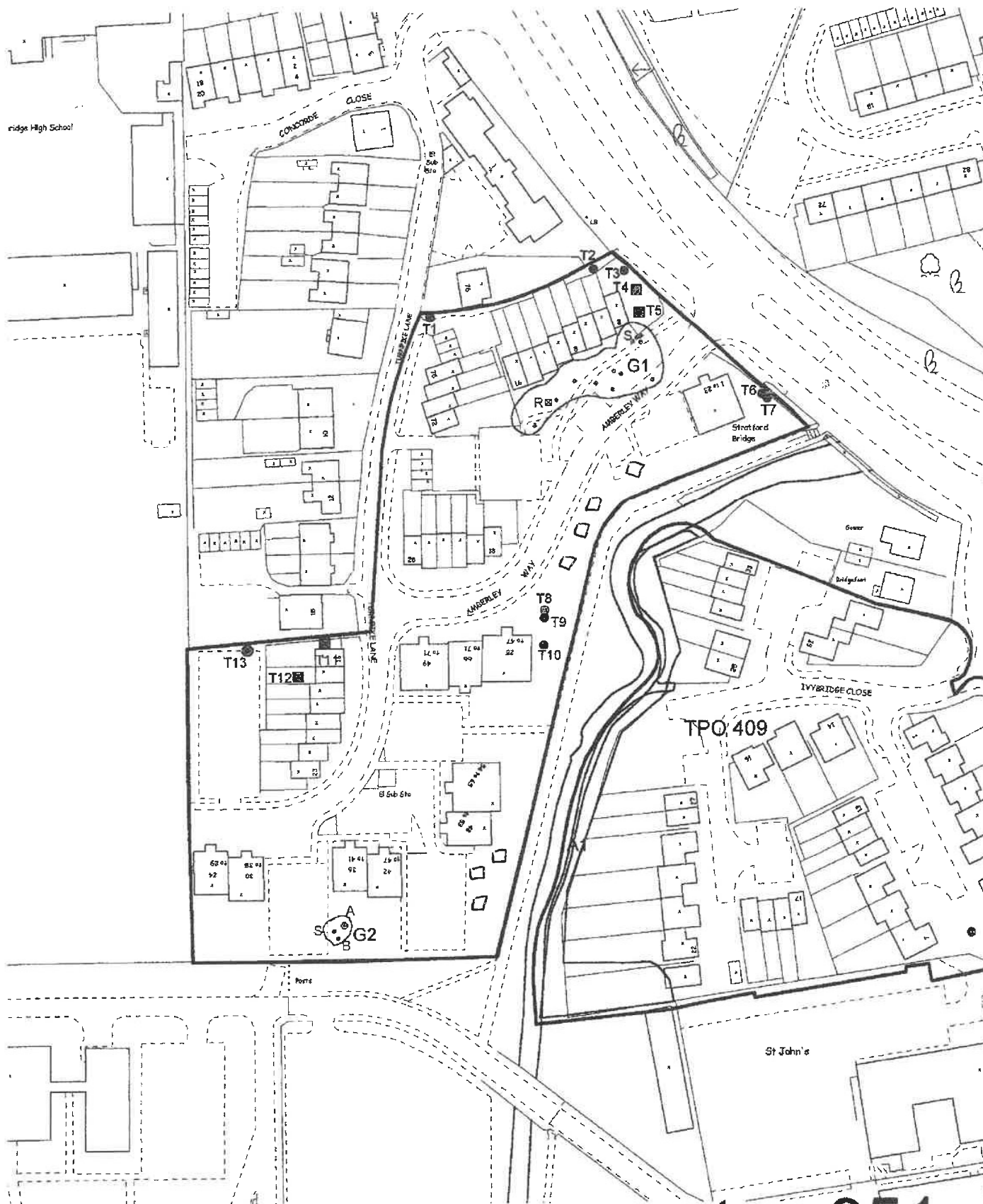
