Where sites have been registered that propose monitoring, the Licensee must submit the survey results, within the same calendar year of completing the survey, using the [Monitoring Report Form \(link\)](#).

Please note that the Bat ER Pilot is ongoing and will entail **an increase in the number and extent of compliance checks** by Natural England for approved Site Registrations. This is in order to evaluate the Pilot's effectiveness at maintaining the favourable conservation status of the roosts impacted. This can include a check of the Survey Report, Licence Return Form, Monitoring Return Form (where applicable)

and include an email, telephone call or site visit. Where a site visit occurs, the presence of the Accredited Consultant is required.
